

Alfie is enjoying a stroll in the crisp morning air of a beautiful fall day.


Try to find at least ten things in the picture which begin with the letter "F."


Autumn is the time of year that many birds migrate. One of the most comon of these is the Robin.




Fall, as Autumn is often called, is a special time of year. It is a time of cool, crisp, clear days. It is a time of falling leaves and harvesting.

In this word ladder, change TIME to FALL by changing only one letter at each step of the ladder.



Possible Answers: time, tame, tale, tall, fall or time, tile, file, fill, fall



1. Autumn is the season which comes after summer and before winter. Autumn is often called fall because this is when most of the leaves fall from the trees.

 Trees that lose their leaves each fall are called deciduous trees.
 Most deciduous trees have broad, flat leaves. Examples include oaks, elms and maples.

3. Trees that do not lose their leaves each fall are called

evergreen trees. Most evergreen trees have needle-like leaves. Examples include pines, firs. and spruces.

4. Summer ends and autumn begins on either the 22nd or the 23rd of September. Many important events have taken place in September over the years.
