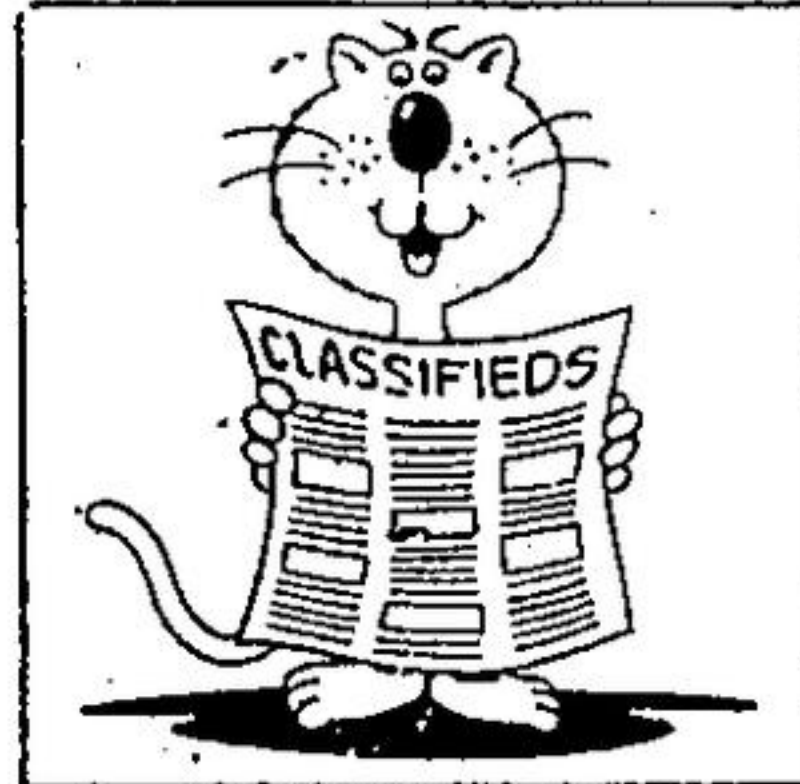
But wait a minute, we all know that tomorrow never comes. There is a very fine line between actually achieving a goal and just wishful thinking. All you really need, to do,

Ben Heppner will appeal at Alliance Church

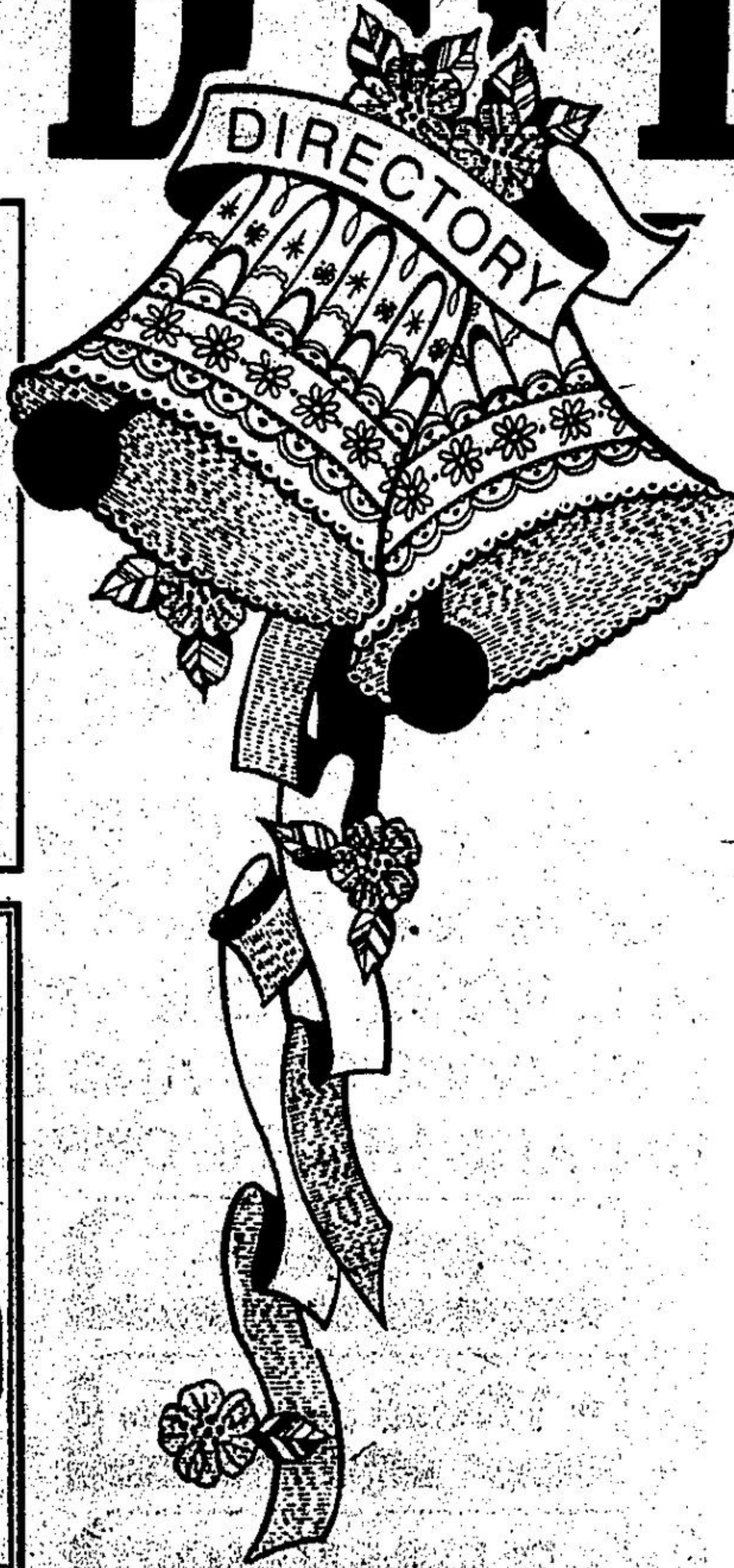
Once again, Georgetown residents are in for a musical treat. Canadian tenor, Ben Heppner, will be in Georgetown for one performance only on Sunday, Sept. 17, 6:30 p.m. at Georgetown Alliance Church.

Ben Heppner has received critical acclaim throughout North America and Europe in opera and orchestral appearances. After graduating from the University of British Columbia, Mr. Heppner won the grand prize of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation Talent Festival and last year was the winner of the Metropolitan Opera Competition. This year's highlights include appearances in Seattle, Montreal, Moscow, Milan, Italy and Vienna.

Most recently, Mr. Heppner has performed in productions of Tannhauser, Rusaika, and Beethoven's Ninth Symphony. These concerts, given for the benefit of international charity, were televised live via satellite in Canada, France and Japan.
