GO adds more parking spaces

GO will add a total of 638 parking spaces at five train stations before Christmas.

Etobicoke North on the Georgetown line will see another 143 spaces, bringing its total to 351.

Contracts for the construction of the additional spaces have been approved by GO's board.

Scarborough station on the Lakeshore East route will receive 154 new spaces, bringing its total capacity to 607.

A new paved and lighted lot will be built at Markham on the Stouffville line, adding 105 spaces to the 100 spaces already there.

Langstaff, on the Richmond Hill route received 150 new spaces earlier this summer. A further 120 spaces are now being added, bringing its total to 412.

On the Bradford line, 67 spaces will be built at King, bringing the total there to 109 and Maple will receive 49 spaces for a total of 69.
