### **ROCK ON**




We were cleaning out some old files here at Rock On, and having a blast reading the grand pronouncements of rockers about their upcoming projects - projects that many times never saw the light of day.

A few of the great ideas that might have been:



guaranteed to raise \$1 million for the Special Olympics, the event tied the Who concert by satellite with five other rock shows being staged simultaneously in San Antonio, Houston, Odessa, Mercedes and Corpus Christi.


