Picking a pattern ensures that "the bride doesn't end up with four toasters and five ironing boards."

Delacourt's delivers china gifts in the areas surrounding Milton. There is a signed card, and the present arrives in attractive gift wrap. Out-of-towners love the service that ensures the gift is a welcomed one.

Georgetown, Acton, Rockwood, Milton and Campbellville customers know Vera Delacourt's china service well.

But the bridal registry, where a bride and groom put their pattern on file, is not the only way to choose that special wedding gift,

There are crystal, statues, in addition to all the most popular china, including Wedgewood, Royal Doulton, Royal Albert and Japanese Noritake patterns.

When choosing gifts for someone, keep in mind that trendiness is not desirable in china, Mrs. Delacourt says.

"Classic patterns will be in long after the very fussy patterns are. The couple will be happy 10 years or 12 years down the road," with a classic choice, she said.

Mrs. Delacourt has been in Milton 30 years and has been in business at her china shop for the past nine years. She is originally from Ireland where she says, ironically, they do not have a

bridal registry for listing china patterns.

Each weekend a registered bride and groom gets married, their names appear on the window of Delacourt's. "It's become a tradition to drive down Main Street and see who's getting married," Mrs.

Delacourt said. This retains the "small town" feeling.

But china patterns are not only for the newly-married, Mrs. Delacourt claims: "We have a very thick file of people who are collecting patterns other than the bridal registry."

 Know realistically your budget and work within it. You don't need to start your marriage with a financial pinch. A "romantic hideaway" is defined by the atmosphere - not the price tag.


