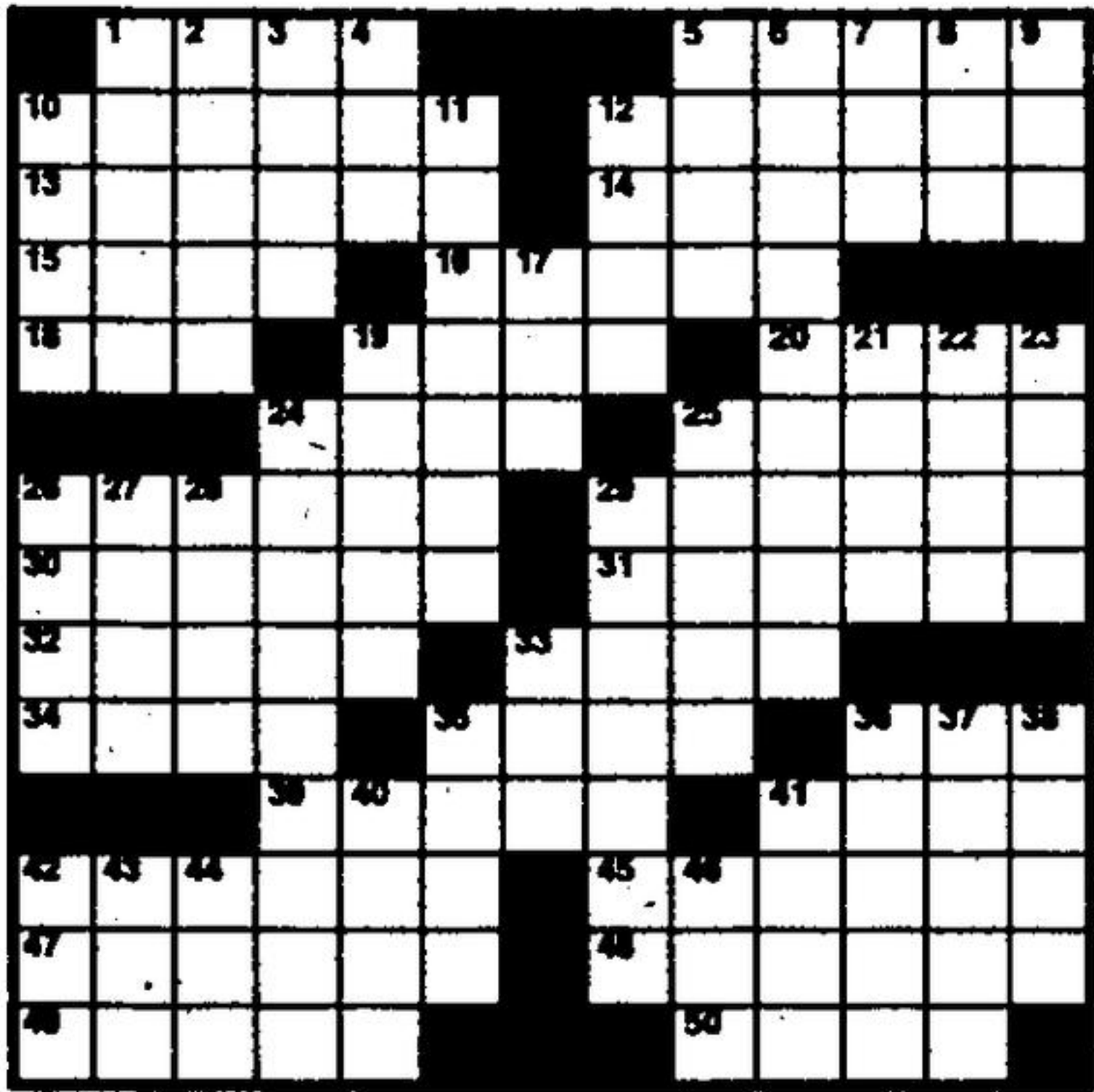


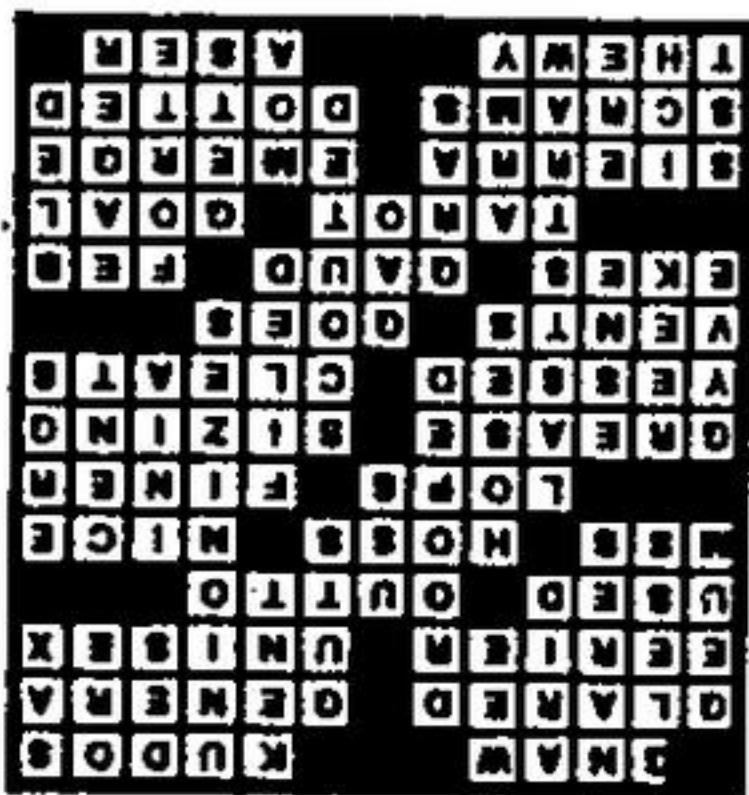

The most valuable book in the world is the Gutenberg Bible, which was first printed in 1455 in Mainz, Germany. This bible was the first book ever printed from moveable metal type. With 1,282 sheepskin pages, the book opens to the width of a card table, notes The Kids' World Almanac.

International Date Line

The Date Line is a zig-zag line that approximately coincides with the 180th meridian, and it is where the calendar dates are separated, according to The World Almanac. The date must be advanced one day when crossing in a westerly direction and set back one day when crossing in an easterly direction.
