Health council needs representation

Halton Regional councillors were not lining up Wednesday to volunteer to serve on a provincial-run district health council.

The Halton District Health Council is a 15-member council made up of health professionals, public members and Regional councillors. It acts as an advisory body to the Ontario ministry of health to suggest changes to the Regional health system.

The council is allowed three councillors from Halton Region but only two came forward Wednesday to serve on the committee. Former member Pat McLaughlin, a Burlington Regional councillor, said he served six years on the council. Six years is the maximum term.

Councillors Peter Arch from Oakville and Brad Clements from Milton will volunteer their services this year for what health council executive director Marlene Longdon says is four to five hours a month.

Halton Hills Coun. Joe Hewitt, presently a member of the health council, said a conflict in his schedule will not allow him to attend the meetings. He will not volunteer for the next term.

The health council is looking for a public member from Georgetown

to sit on the committee.

Mrs. Longdon said the role will require about eight to 10 hours month.

Oakville Regional Coun. John Graham led an attack on the health council. He said Oakville is "over-doctored", and the health council is not doing its job in determining the Region's needs.

Coun. Bill Johnson from Milton said there is a three-week wait for a physiotherapist in his town. He said there the health council's contribution to the Region should be investigated.

But Regional Health Commissioner Dr. Graham Pollett said there are no plans to investigate the district health councils across Ontario. Coun. Clements said he "has no problem with the present (health council) mandate. I'm concerned with the future mandate." Mr. Clements volunteered as a member of the council after only Mr. Arch came forward.

Coun. McLaughlin responded to attacks on the health council by

saying that there is a lot of work that goes on behind the scenes.

"It's very easy to get up here (at Regional council) and say they don't do anything," he said.
