

# OHL games to be televised

The Ontario Hockey League's TV Game-of-the-Week will appear on the Global Television Network for its eighth consecutive season of Saturday afternoons starting on Saturday, Jan. 6, 1990.

The 1990 telecasts feature 11 of the 15 teams including the defending league champion Peterborough Petes twice. Three teams,

including the Dukes of Hamilton, London Knights and Ottawa 67's, are on three telecasts each while two other teams in addition to the Petes - Kitchener Rangers and Oshawa Generals - are on twice each.

The broadcast crew of play-by-play man Dave Quinn, color commentator Sherry Bassin and host Jack Miller returns for its third season. Quinn and Bassin are back for their fifth season on the telecasts while Miller, who also conducts between-period interviews, is starting his third year. Producer and director Ed Mercel returns for his seventh season to guide all the action behind the scenes.

Bassin is also the Director of Operations of the OHL's Sault Ste. Marie Greyhounds while Miller has been the play-by-play announcer for the Belleville Bulls radio broadcasts for the past eight seasons.

"Once again on Saturday afternoons, the OHL TV Game-of-the-Week will provide high-calibre hockey entertainment to television audiences across this province," said David E. Branch, Commissioner of the OHL. "We are proud to showcase on Global TV some of the top on-ice talent competing in junior hockey today and many of these players will also be seen on TV screens next season, competing in the National Hockey League."
