health nurse attends this program regularly to discuss infant development and to answer questions new mothers may have.

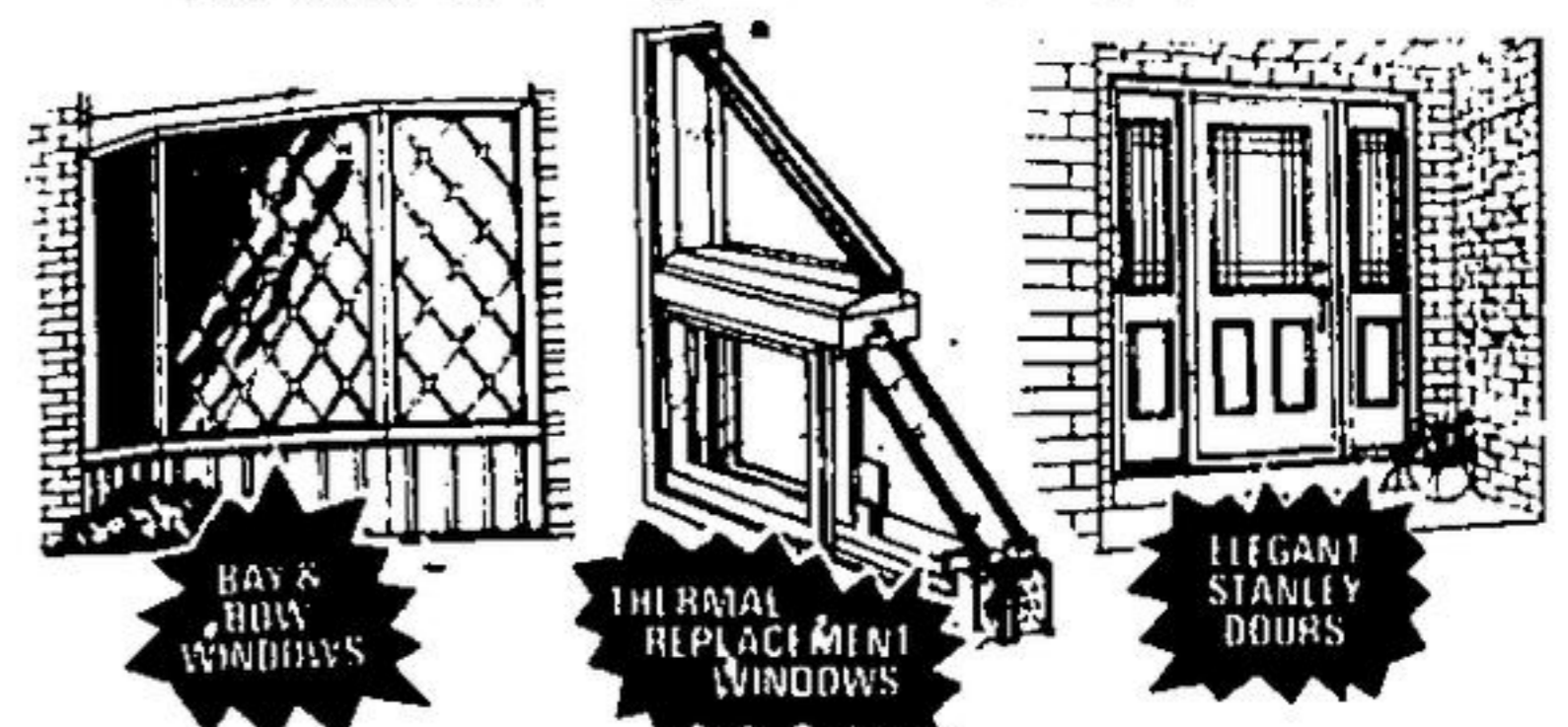
Tuesday afternoon is "Time With Mom" geared for the older pre-schooler, (ages 3-5) with planned activities for both mom and child.
