
# Scandanavian Search


### Snowflake Silhouette

4 medium-sized potatoes

onion


½ teaspoon salt

2 cups milk

2 tablespoons butter

½ tablespoon parsley

1/8 teaspoon pepper



1. Peel each potato and cut into quarters.

2. Peel and chop onion. Put potatoes, onion, and salt in a heavy pan and cover with water.

3. Bring water to a boil and let boil for 15-20 minutes. Without draining, mash potatoes and onion in the pan.

4. Add milk slowly, stirring constantly. Add butter, parsley, and pepper.

5. Stir over medium heat until soup is smooth and hot.
