

Police Beat

Impaired charge

Halton Regional Police charged a 42-year-old Acton man with impaired driving after a man was seen driving a vehicle erratically northbound on Churchill Road in Acton early Saturday morning. Police followed the vehicle to MacDonald Boulevard and Division Street and then pulled it over.

Tires slashed

Tires on three vehicles were slashed with a half-inch-wide knife blade in Acton overnight Dec. 15.

Police say one woman saw four or five 12- and 13-year-olds "acting rowdy" in the area of a Mill Street residence where two tires on a 1976 Chevrolet were slashed. Damage was estimated to be \$200. Police say the youths may or may not have caused the damage.

Someone also slashed two tires on a 1982 Mazda parked in the area of Acton Boulevard causing about \$200 damage.

In a third incident someone caused \$100 damage after slashing the right front tire on a 1989 Ford parked on Rosemary Street.

Police have no suspects for any of the incidents.

Charge laid

Police laid a charge of impaired driving after finding a 27-year-old Milton man behind the steering wheel of a car in which the car motor was running at a Guelph Street and Maple Avenue service station lot in Georgetown early Saturday morning. A court date has yet to be scheduled.

Shoplifting charge

Someone tried to steal a \$30 wallet from the Olde Hide House in Acton last Friday afternoon. Police say a store security officer stopped a man as he was paying for another wallet. A 29-year-old Georgetown man has been charged with shoplifting in connection with the incident. He is scheduled to appear in court Jan. 29.

Screen torn

Police charged a 16-year-old Georgetown youth with mischief under \$1,000 after the front door screen of a Moore Park Crescent residence in Georgetown was ripped during the night of Dec. 2. The residence's owner told police a youth used a knife to rip the screen after being told to leave the house during a party. A Jan. 2 court date has been scheduled in

connection with the incident.

Window smashed

Someone smashed the driver's side window of a 1975 Chevrolet parked outside a Hewson Crescent house in Georgetown causing \$100 damage sometime over the weekend.

\$200 damage

Police report someone caused about \$200 damage to a 1985 Plymouth parked in the area of Ewing Street in Georgetown after smashing the rear window of the car overnight Dec. 16.

\$500 damage

Someone drove up to a car parked outside a Wilbur Street residence in Acton and then

smashed the windows of the vehicle with a hammer, a witness told police. The damage was estimated to be \$500.

Police have no suspects. The witness didn't know the license plate of the culprit's vehicle.

Grill stolen

Police say someone stole a grill valued at \$100 from a demolished 1984 van parked in an auto recycling area at Sideroad 32 in Halton Hills overnight Friday.

Man charged

Police charged a 21-year-old Acton man with impaired driving following a two-car collision at Mill Street East and Wilbur Street in Acton during the early morning of Dec. 2. A 1982 Plymouth driven by a 21-year-old man was stopped in the intersection forcing the driver of a 1988 Chevrolet to try to stop quickly to avoid a collision. But the driver of the Chevrolet, a 24-year-old Guelph man, was unable to stop the vehicle in time.

The Plymouth was demolished.

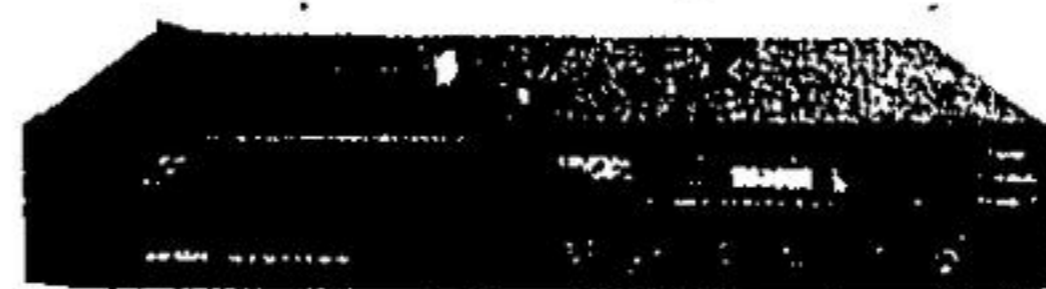

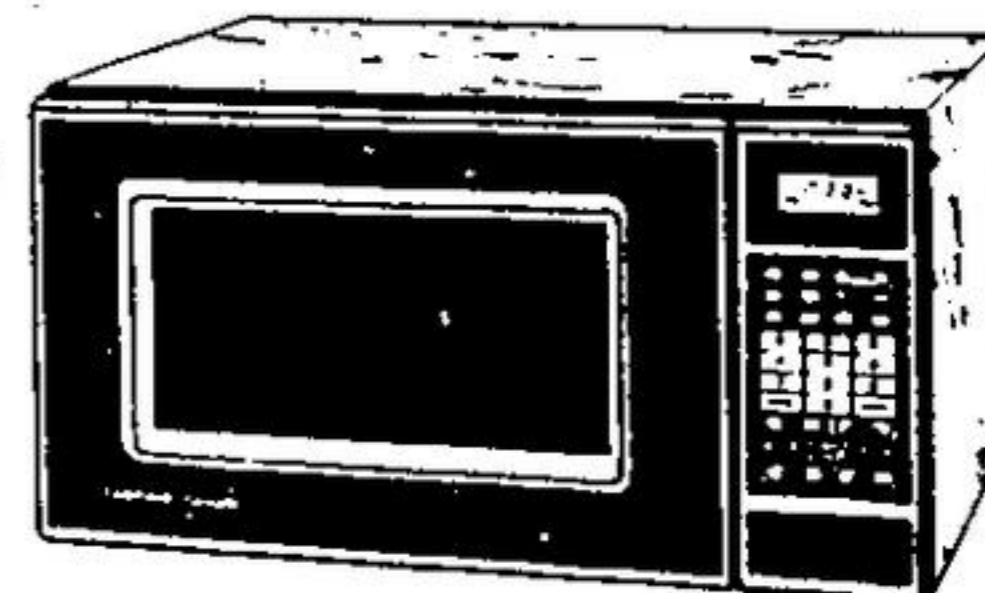

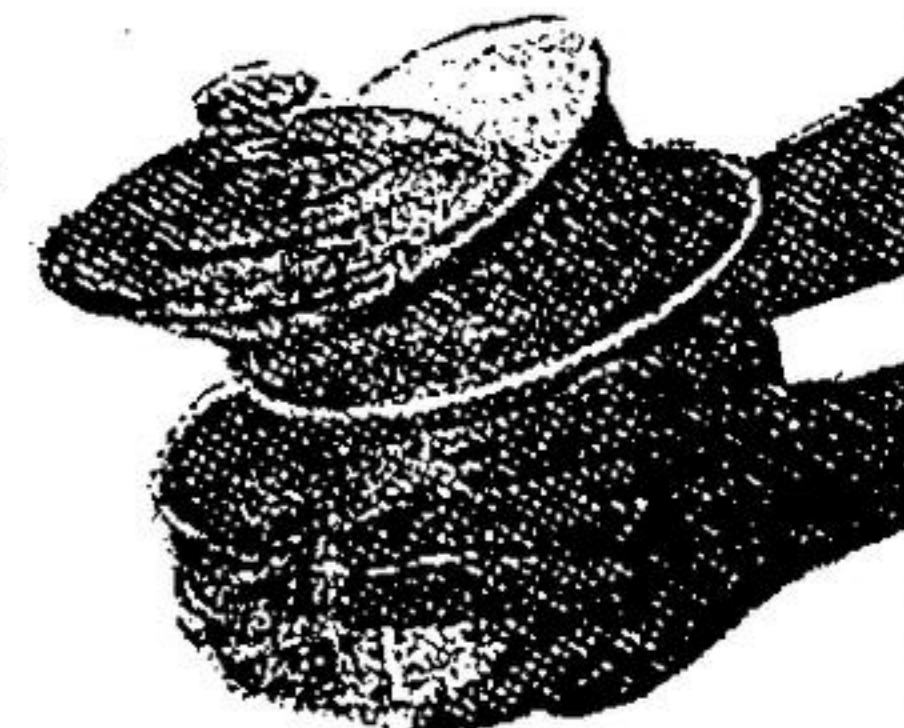
