COCOA GINGERBREAD GIFT TAGS

all purpose flour 750 ml. 3 cups FRY'S COCOA 125 ml. 1 2 cup 2 mL baking soda 1/2 tsp

15 mL 1 thsp ginger, ground 250 mL butter, softened 1 cup 250 ml. l cup sugar 175 mL molasses Decorator Frosting

Sift together flour, Fry's Cocoa, baking soda and ginger. Cream butter until light: gradually beat in sugar and molasses. Beat in egg. Blend in dry ingredients, part at a time, to form stiff dough. Chill dough one hour or until firm enough to roll. Roll dough, part at a time, on lightly floured board to 1/8inch (3 mm) thickness. Cut out rectangles or other shapes for gift tags. Use a drinking straw to make a hole in each cookie for ribbon. Place on ungreased cookie sheets. Bake in preheated 350°F (180°C) oven 8 to 10 minutes or until done. Cool slightly before removing from pans; cool completely on wire racks. Decorate and write names with Decorator Frosting.

Makes about 4 to 5 dozen cookies.

Decorator Frosting:

Beat 2 egg whites until frothy. Gradually beat in 3 cups (750 mL) sifted icing sugar: continue beating until stiff peaks form. Place frosting in small pastry bag fitted with fine

nozzle and decorate cookies as desired.

CRISP CHOCOLATE HAZELNUT COOKIES

1-1-2 cups all purpose flour - 375 mL icing sugar 250 mL l cup 1.3 cup FRY'S COCOA 75 ml. 250 ml. butter, softened ground toasted 250 mL I cup hazelnuts

Sift together flour, sugar and

Fry's Cocoa. Cream butter. Gradually blend in dry ingredients and nuts. Shape dough into 1-inch (2.5 cm) balls. Place on ungreased cookie sheets. Flatten to 1/8-inch (3 mm) thickness with bottom of glass dipped in granulated sugar. Bake in 300°F (150°C) oven 20 to 25 minutes or until done. Cool slightly before removing from pan.

Makes about 3 dozen.


For Christmas I would like PJ Sparkle, a little pony, Flower Making Basket, markers or whatever else you have on your sleigh.
