

Police Beat

Slushy roads

Slushy roads were said to be the cause of a two-car collision near 300 Guelph Street in Georgetown Tuesday morning. Halton Regional Police say a 1977 Ford LTD, driven by a Georgetown man, 21, collided with a 1985 Pontiac driven by a Windsor woman, 26. Police say the Ford went out of control, swerving almost head-on into the Pontiac. Both cars received minor damage. No charges were laid. Police report no injuries.

Minor damage

A 1986 Mercury reversing from a Sumach Trail driveway struck a 1989 Ford Saturday morning, causing minor damage to the Ford. No charges were laid against the Mercury driver, a Georgetown man, 49. Police say the car's safety brake was not in operation. There were no injuries reported in the collision.

Mailbox struck

A car driven by an Acton woman swerved to avoid an unidentified animal on Frist Line near Sideroad 17 Saturday, and struck a roadside mailbox. Halton police say a 1988 Oldsmobile driven by an Acton

woman, 46, was southbound on First Line when an animal ran in front of the car on ice-slicked roadways.

The car was moderately damaged. No charges were laid.

Tree struck

A Georgetown man whose 1985 Chevrolet struck a tree on Tenth Line south of Erin Thursday night will face a Halton Regional Police charge of careless driving.

The Georgetown man, 48, was driving the Chevrolet southbound on a curve near Sideroad 32 around 11 p.m. The car failed to round the right curve and hit a tree straight ahead, police say. The car was abandoned at the accident scene. Police say the driver was contacted at his residence following the accident.

The driver received minor injuries. The car was severely damaged.

Man charged

A Waterford man was charged with careless driving Thursday night following an accident that sent three people to Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital for observation. The man, 26, was driving a 1986 Chevrolet that was southbound on Main Street near Mill Street when it struck a 1980 Buick that came to a stop seconds before. Both the Chevrolet and the Buick which was driven by an Acton man, 24, were moderately damaged.

Both drivers and a passenger in the Chevrolet went to Georgetown hospital and were released.

No charges

A Georgetown woman will not be charged by Halton Regional Police after her car reversing from a parking spot on Delrex Boulevard backed into a parked 1983 Mercury, owned by a Brampton man. The Georgetown woman, 46, was driving a 1981 Chevrolet about 6:30 Thursday night when the car struck the Mercury. Police say there will be no charges because the accident occurred on private property.

Vehicles collide

A Barrie man will face a charge of following too closely after his car struck a 1988 Mazda pick-up driven by a Campbellville man in Georgetown Thursday afternoon. A 1978 Ford pick-up driven by the Barrie man, 41, struck the Mazda that had stopped to avoid collision with a third car ahead. The Ford and Mazda were lightly damaged. No one was injured, police say.

Halton police investigate over 50 house entries

Halton Regional Police in Burlington are actively investigating over 50 house entries that have taken place since October this year.

The suspects are still active at this time and the police investigation estimate over \$250,000 in household property has been stolen. Included in the stolen items are: microwaves, cameras, Royal Doulton figurines, computers, V.C.R.s, stereos, TVs, cash and jewellery.

The largest percentage of the entries have been taking place between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. with the remainder taking place in the early evening hours. There does not appear to be any pattern to the location of the entries. The thieves have struck in all the

residential areas of Burlington. Entry is usually gained through a rear door or window.

In some instances it is obvious a truck would have been required to transport the stolen items as furniture and large appliances are stolen.
