

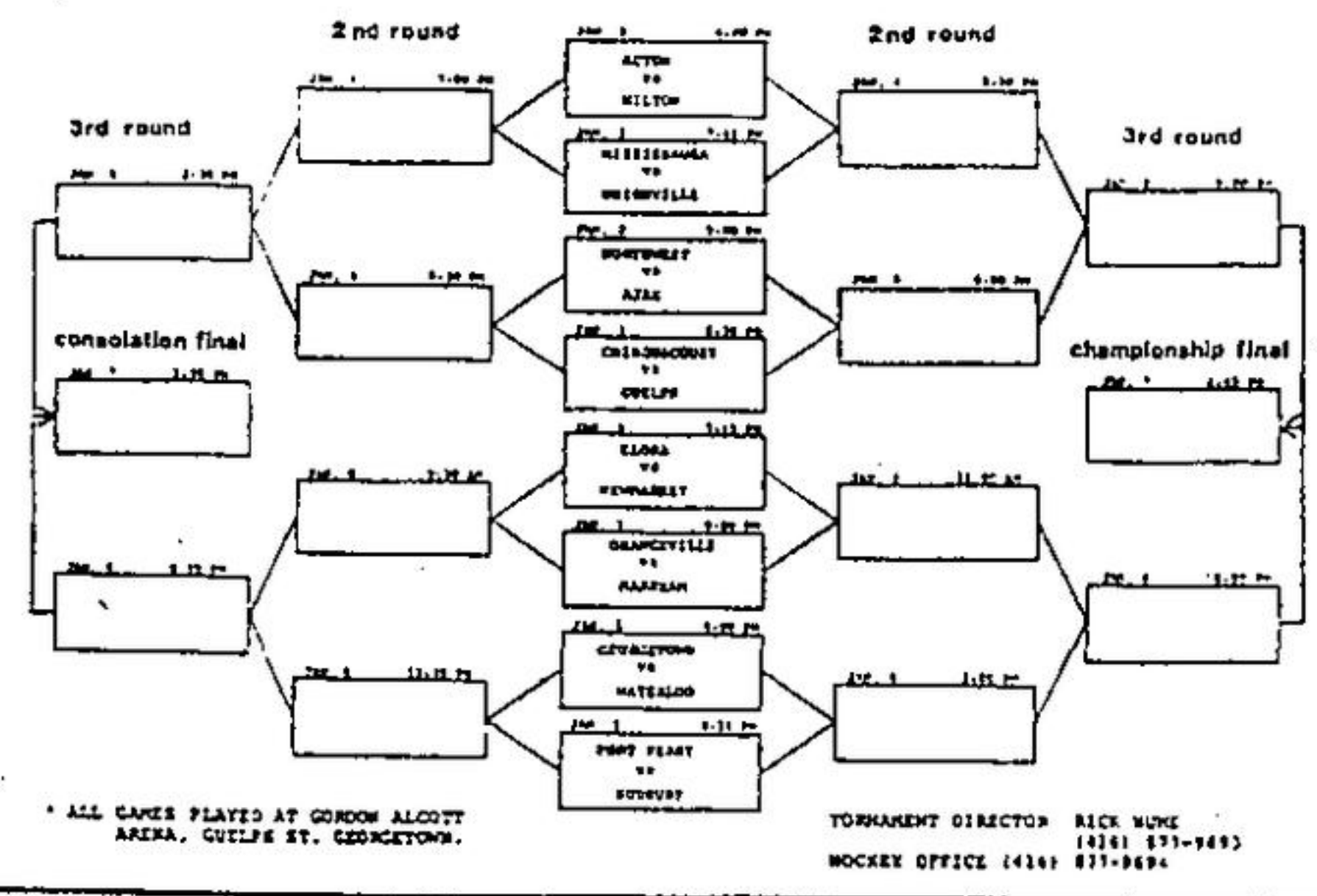
Midget tournament headlines hockey

Sports coupes market is fiercely contested

What carries two grown-ups and two kids in comfort, handles twisty roads with ease, goes about 25 miles on a gallon of gas, costs in the neighborhood of \$20,000 and looks terrific in red? A 2+2 sports coupe.

Or more precisely, an Acura Integra GS, a Ford Probe GT, a Nissan 240SX SE, a Plymouth Laser RS Turbo and a Toyota Celica GT-S.

From their curb weight (just under 3,000 pounds each), to their powerplants (each has a multi-valve 4-cylinder engine), to their steering (each has power-assisted rack & pinion), their specifications are very similar. And with their wedge-of-cheese exterior styling, nine out of ten folks probably couldn't tell them apart without looking at their name plates.

So, if you're a shopper in this fiercely contested segment of the car market, how do you choose among these five peas in a pod? The editors of Road & Track decided to find out in a comparison road test for the magazine's January issue.

Starting at the top of the alphabet, the Acura Integra GS is, above all,

Playing fields must be booked

The Halton Hills Recreation and Parks Department is well into planning and procedures for the use of sports fields in the area for 1990. It is requested that the necessary requests for use of playing fields in Halton Hills be submitted to the department as soon as possible.

1990 BOOKING PROCEDURES

1. We are asking all contacts to complete and return the 1990 requests for park use and/or tournaments by Feb. 28. Requests received after Feb. 28 will be dependent upon availability of fields.
2. All requests will be reviewed with priority being given to affiliated minor groups, local over non-local, previous year's users and games over practices and tournaments.
3. Please see the back of the Application Form for complete booking procedures.

1990 PLAYING SEASON

The 1990 Ball Diamond Palying Season, weather permitting, will run from Monday, May 7 to Sunday, Sept. 30, except for the Middle Diamond at Prospect Park. The Middle Diamond (No. 2) at Prospect Park, due to field reconstruction, will not be available until July 1 and will not be lit for the 1990 season.

Alcott, Cedarvale and the Georgetown District High School field will be available Monday, May 21 to Sunday, Sept. 19. Permits for all remaining soccer fields will be issued for Monday, May 7 to Sunday, Sept. 19 weather permitting. We will have use of the Meadowglen field for the whole season in 1990.

1990 RATES

There will be a slight increase in both seasonal fees for regular users (by \$5/youth team and \$10/adult team) to \$35/youth and \$70/team for adults. A full fee schedule will be available in February.

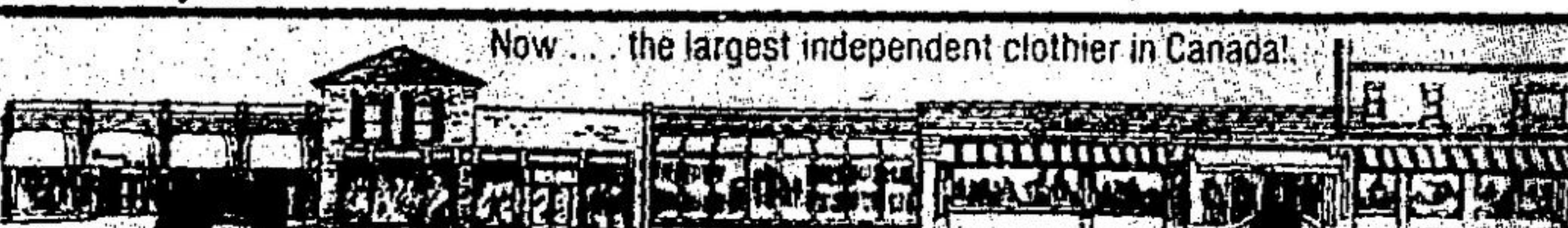
