

### \$8,000 damage

Halton Regional Police estimate there was \$8,000 in damage and lost goods after someone broke into a store on Guelph Street in Halton Hills between 6:50 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. Jan. 19. The estimate is tentative because the owners were unable to provide a complete list of items stolen. Police say the front door glass was smashed.

### \$10,000 damage

Someone caused an estimated \$10,000 damage to an abandoned house and garage between Dec. 24 and Jan. 20 at noon, police say. The house is located near Highway 7 and Sideroad 22. Police found a large number of beer bottles and the remains of a bonfire. Police say three garage bay doors were removed and destroyed and holes were made in the walls.

### Youths arrested

Two youths were arrested following an incident in which a Globe and Mail newspaper box was carried to the back of the Canada Post Office building in Acton and shaken upside down to release money, police say. The incident happened on Jan. 20 at 10:40 a.m., police say. The two youths have been released to their mothers, police say.

### Car scratched

A 1990 Laser received \$500 damage after someone scratched the car in a Norval parking lot between midnight and 1:30 a.m. on Jan. 20, police say. Somebody dragged an unknown object along the left side of the victim's car leaving two distinct marks, police say.

### \$300 damage

A Pontiac on Park Avenue in Georgetown received \$300 damage when someone scratched the front of the car and took the emblem half way off between Dec. 1 and Jan. 18, police say. The scratches were made with an unknown object.

### Window smashed

A window and screen on a River Drive building in Georgetown were broken, causing approximately \$100 damage during the early morning hours Jan. 20.

### Power saw stolen

Headphones and a power saw were taken from a church near the intersection of Highway 25 and Highway 7 in Acton between Jan. 14, 3 p.m. and Jan. 16, 7 p.m., police say. The person or persons entered through a basement window and police say they were possibly looking for money. They found no money and took the only two items with any apparent value, police say. Nothing was reported damaged and money is not kept in the church.

Police have charged a 54-year-old Milton woman with following too closely after the 1988 Ford she was driving collided with a 1990 GMC, driven by a 32-year-old Hornby woman, Jan. 17 at 3:30 p.m. The GMC was stopped eastbound on Steeles Avenue trying to make a left turn onto Fifth Line when the Ford that was travelling behind the GMC collided with it. The GMC was pushed into the westbound lane but managed to swerve back into the eastbound lane avoiding oncoming traffic, police noted.
