Youth confesses to thefts

A Halton Hills youth has confessed to Halton Regional Police of committing over 18 thefts from automobiles in 1989.

Police spotted a 1988 Ford being operated in a suspicious manner in the area of Guelph Street and Mountainview Road Jan. 31 at approximately 10:30 in the evening.

Police stopped the car and asked to search it. According to police the occupants consented to the search. The police found a pair of needle-nose pliers, two screwdrivers and a notched metal band, known as a "slim jim," under one of the seats.

The police also found a stolen stereo amplifier in the trunk of the car, worth approximately \$400, which the youth admitted to taking.

After an interview with the youth, police say they received an admission of guilt in 18 other cases throughout the 1989 year.

The other suspect is a 19-year-old man from the Halton Hills area. He has been charged with possession of stolen property.

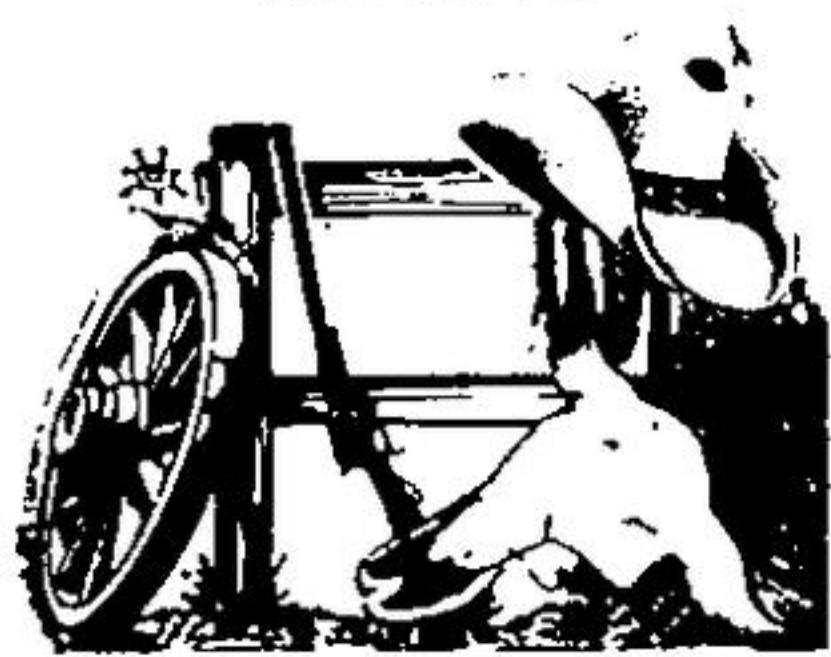

Now is the time to renew your Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS*)

Renewal application kits have been mailed to everyone who receives the Guaranteed Income Supplement. If you have already returned your completed application, it is now being processed. If approved, your payments will continue in April.

If you have not returned your application, you should do so today in order to avoid an interruption in your payments. When applying, please remember to:

- fill out your renewal application completely;
- include all the necessary income information;

- return your renewal application in the self-addressed envelope by **March 31, 1990.**

If you did not receive your renewal kit, or if you want more information, contact your nearest Income Security Programs office. The telephone number and address are in the government listings of the telephone book under "Health and Welfare Canada, Income Security Programs."

*The Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) is an income-tested, monthly benefit for Old Age Security pensioners with limited income apart from the Old Age Security pension.
