The town is considering widening Guelph Street in Georgetown and engineers are looking for your ideas on how to do it.

Halton Hills residents will get the chance Thursday night at a public meeting to hear various alternatives being considered by the town on how Guelph Street between Maple Avenue and Main Street should be widened.

The various alternatives being considered include widening the strip from two lanes to three, four or five lanes, said the town's manager of engineering services, Tim Stuart.

Another alternative Mr. Stuart said is not widening the road and only upgrading it.

Mr. Stuart couldn't say when construction on athe strip would take place. He did say it was not part of the town's 1990 five-year capital budget forecast.


