


Branching out



CVCA targets seven projects in town in coming months

Halton Regional council's contribution to the Credit Valley Conservation Authority will increase by 7.5 per cent this year.

Just over \$57,000 raised this year through regional taxes, will go to the CVCA, which represents about a \$4,000 jump in tax money over last year.

The mandate of the CVCA is to control development along the banks of the Credit River valley to protect the watershed.

Council also approved Halton Hills' increased tax levy to collect just over \$290,000 for special CVCA projects in Halton Hills. These projects involve Willow Park, Irwin Crescent, Metcalf Court, the Jarvie Property, the Halton Flour Dam and the Paper Mill Dam.

Eleven municipalities contribute to the CVCA's budget and Halton's share this year according to the CVCA amounts to just over \$58,500.

The total 1990 CVCA budget is almost \$1.5 million which represents an 11.5 per cent increase in spending over last year.


But councillors supported Regional staff's opinion that the provincial government is responsible for \$1,300 of the Region's share of the CVCA's budget.

They directed staff to petition the government to pay this amount.

According to the staff report the provincial government is required to pay 50 to 55 per cent of the CVCA's general administration, operations and capital projects. But funding provided by the province for the total CVCA budget falls short by almost 33,000, the report says. And \$1,300 represents Halton's share of the shortfall.

The province has increased spending by four per cent which doesn't cover provincial initiatives that apply to the CVCA, says the CVCA general manager Vicki Barron.

The new costs incurred include the implementation of a pay equity plan, the employer health tax and the Workplace Hazardous Material Information System, said Ms. Barron.
