The branch mourns the passing of our comrade Harry Hale. A First World War veteran who served with the London Scottish Regiment as part of the British Expeditionary Force who went to France in 1914. He later transferred to the Royal Flying Corps and served as an aero engine mechanic.

Emigrating to Canada in 1920 he spent his entire working life in the service of the Provincial Paper Company.

A member of the Royal Canadian Legion since its formation in 1928, Harry served on the branch executive during the early years. He will be best remembered for his considerable talent as an entertainer at Legion functions. Our deepest sympathy goes out to his family and many friends at this time.
