## The New Kids are growing up

Now that the New Kids On The Block have cornered the teenybopper market, they may aim at the old folk - senior high school students.

The Boston-area pop music group has sparked more shricks from the soprano set than any group since the Beatles. The quintet has captured the adulation of not only early teens, but of preteen girls.

Their recent Canadian concert tour has left thousands of young girls with strained vocal cords. Even 12-and-13-year-olds can only scream for so long.

The New Kids, with their elaborate choreography, sugardripping lyrics and wholesome image, are a carefully packaged event. Each of the quintet - the average age is 19 - is already a millionaire. Their breakthrough second album, Hangin' Tough, has passed the 16-million sales mark.

Maurice Starr is the man behind the Kids. Seven years ago he formed the New Edition, five black performers whose hits included Candy Girl.

He began auditions in 1984 for a new group - a group that became New Kids On The Block.

"Given the demographics of the country and the history of the music business, I figured that five



white kids could be very big," he told The New Times. "If New Edition was as big as they were, I could imagine what would happen if white kids were doing the same thing."


