What counts most at the Masters tourney?

© 1990 NEWSPAPER ENTERPRISE ASSN. Scott Hoch won more than \$670,000 last year. He was the 10th leading money winner in 1989 on the PGA Tour. He began this year ranked 24th among golf's career money winners with just over \$2.5 million. In 10 years on the tour, he's won four tournaments, most recently the 1989 Las Vegas Invitational.

Unfortunately, when Scott Hoch's name is mentioned, the first thing golf fans think of isn't his stat sheet - it's

the Masters.

It was at the Augusta National Golf Club — golf's "Sistine Chapel" — that Hoch missed a 24-inch putt last year on the first hole of his sudden death playoff with Nick Faldo. That putt could have earned the green jacket awarded to the Masters winner. Hoch's miss underlined the words of writer Bernard Darwin - "Golf is not a funeral, though both can be very sad affairs."

When the 1990 Masters gets underway on Thursday, April 5, golf's elite will try to wrest the crown from Faldo. The odds are against another victory for the Englishman - only. once in the tournament's 53-year history has a player won in successive years: Jack Nicklaus in 1965 and

In six previous encounters this year Stoney Creek had not beaten the Major Peewees


The · Bodanis Bruins controlled play for much of the game, except for the last four minutes of the second period, when the visitors scored three times to take a 5-3 lead.




