Three Georgetown residents were contributors to the Peel Select Volleyball Program. Starting middle attacker Holly Sones finished this weekend's tournament with a kill percentage of 51

per cent and shot down the Eclipse dynamite duo in the middle with her blocking. Sarah Broughton served 3 aces and played her personal best on Saturday. The Georgetown girls were members of Georgetown's 4th place finishing team at OFSA. Both girls are in Grade 11 at Georgetown District High School. Assistant coach John Hnativ, also from Georgetown, anticipates a peaking performance one month in Edmonton at the National from the girls championships being held on May 10-14.

The team honed their skills during the March Break by competing in Cuba against the National "B" Team. Cuba is currently regarded

as the strongest volleyball country in the world due to their regimented training programs, averaging 4 hours daily for girls.

The Peel Selects parents are currently fund raising every Tuesday night on Hwy. 7 and Hwy. 10 Bingo Hall for this venture. The selects team welcomes anyone's support for their serious bid for a medal at the National Championships in Edmonton.
