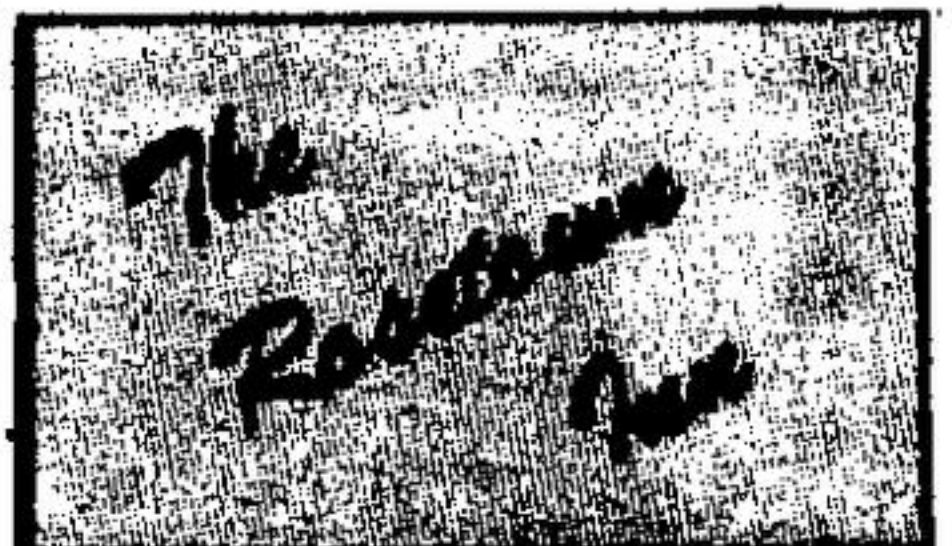


Brothers and sisters
