#### \$1,000 damage

Halton Regional Police say somebody broke into the Water Pollution Centre in Acton on Churchill Road between 4 p.m. May 18 and 7:30 a.m. May 19. A lock to the compound was cut and both buildings were broken into. One building was entered through a broken window and the other building was entered through an air conditioning opening. #### Car demolished

A 1989 Pontiac, driven by a 38-


