

Police Beat

\$1,000 damage

Halton Regional Police say somebody broke into the Water Pollution Centre in Acton on Churchill Road between 4 p.m. May 18 and 7:30 a.m. May 19. A lock to the compound was cut and both buildings were broken into. One building was entered through a broken window and the other building was entered through an air conditioning opening. Both buildings were ransacked and the culprit escaped with \$20 in change. Approximately \$1,000 damage was caused by the break-in.

Car demolished

A 1989 Pontiac, driven by a 38-

year-old Norval woman, was travelling south on the Tenth Line at 10:30 a.m. May 15, when the car's wheels caught the gravel shoulder and pulled the vehicle into the ditch. The vehicle's left front corner dug into the ground and flipped the car onto its roof. The driver received minor injuries, police say. The car was demolished.

Two-car collision

A two-car collision at the intersection of Maple Avenue and Main Street at 1:35 a.m. May 17 has resulted in police laying a charge of careless driving. A 1990 Pontiac, driven by a 32-year-old Fonthill man, was in the process of making a right-hand turn onto Main Street when a 1983 Mazda, driven by a 25-year-old Georgetown woman, collided

with the Pontiac. The Pontiac received light damage and the Mazda received moderate damage.

Sign hit

A 1985 Chevrolet, driven by a 51-year-old Glen Williams woman, was travelling west on Sideroad 17 in dense fog when the car skidded off the road and struck a road sign at 11 p.m. May 16. Police have not laid charges in the case.

Clothes stolen

A man who went swimming in the pool on Acton Boulevard returned to the changing room to

find his clothes missing at 8:45 p.m. May 17. His clothes were discovered in a nearby toilet cubicle with car keys and \$20 missing from his pockets. Police have recovered the missing items and have charged a 15-year-old youth with theft under \$1,000. The youth will appear in court June 15.

Charge laid

Police have laid charges of impaired driving after a May 16 accident. A 1989 Jeep received light damage when it hit a fence, damaging the fence posts, while driving through a field, police say. The 35-year-old Georgetown man driving the Jeep was uninjured, police say. The accident

occurred at 1 a.m. near the intersection of Ninth Line and Sideroad 32.

Minimal injuries

Police say a woman received minimal injuries when two cars collided at the intersection of Main Street and Henry Street at 6 p.m. May 17. A 1986 Pontiac, driven by a 22-year-old Georgetown woman, which was travelling north on Main Street had stopped waiting for traffic to clear to turn left onto Henry Street. A 1990 Chrysler, driven by a 47-year-old man, collided with the Pontiac. Both cars received moderate damage.

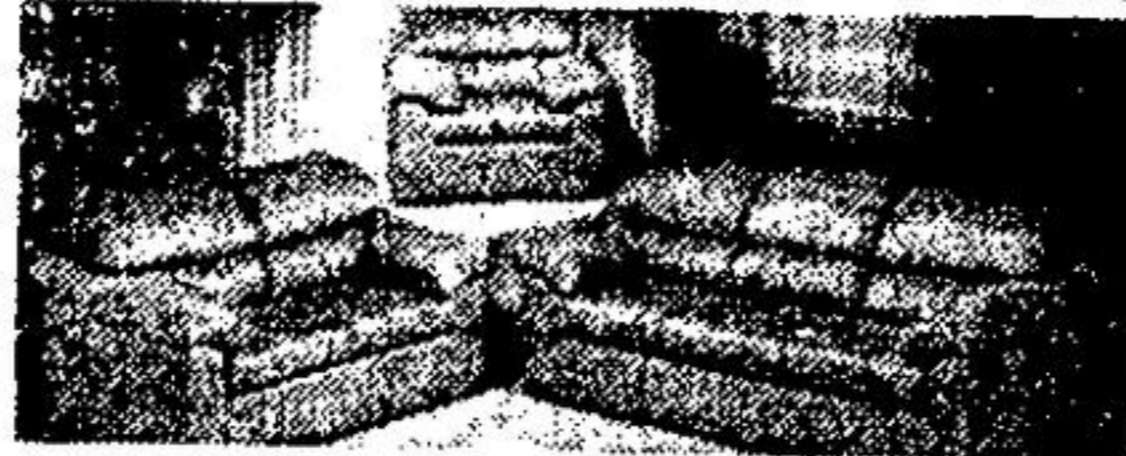
