**C.C.P. Liquidators moves to Main St.**

The six-year-old Halton Hills business known as C.C.P. Liquidators has found home base on Main Street in Georgetown, says its owner Dave Tarzwell.

C.C.P. Liquidators is known locally for its large sales of merchandise from bankrupt businesses. Mr. Tarzwell buys stock from companies that are going out of business and then sells them for half the retail price. He also tries to create as much savings as possible for his customers, selling some stock at up to 80 per cent off the retail price whenever he can.

If a person does not recognize the name of the company, he or she should recognize the large shoe sales that have popped up in the local arenas, Mr. Tarzwell said.

It is the same quality merchandise that can be bought at a store for half the price, he said. Unfortunately, Mr. Tarzwell can never be too certain about what he

will have in stock. Whether it's a small or large company that is going out of business, C.C.P. Liquidators will buy their stock and sell it, but it's impossible to tell what businesses are going out of business before they go out of business, he said. "One day it could be TV's, the next day it could be golf clubs," he added.

Mr. Tarzwell stressed the items in his store are quality first-run merchandise and not second-hand material.

What Mr. Tarzwell is planning to do is run items for sale before events so people can save "50 per cent off before you need it." What's the use of selling Christmas trees after Christmas," he asked.

The 38-year-old businessman has been in the retail industry for 15 years but only started buying bankrupt stock six years ago.

He used to own a waterbed manufacturing company and sold through a retail store that went

bankrupt. He bought his waterbeds back to try to make some of his investment back. "I did so well on that I went further," he said.

Within the C.C.P. Liquidators store is another store called Nintendo World. This allows children to buy, trade, sell and rent all games and accessories of Nintendo and Game Boy without forcing them to ride a bike out to Country Lane, Mr. Tarzwell said.

Mr. Tarzwell isn't settling back in his business as he already has started making plans to expand the basement of the new building.

C.C.P. Liquidators official grand opening was last Wednesday.

Please forward a letter to the Town stating your name, address and qualifications, as well as a telephone number by means of which you may be reached during the day.

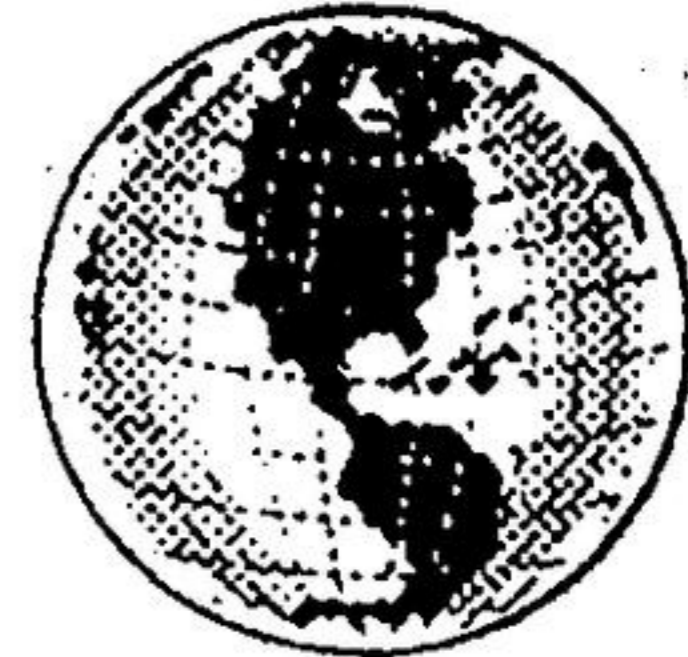
