Lake Huron Circle Tour

SARNIA - On a large yacht in the international waters between Ontario and Michigan, Ken Black, Ontario's Minister of Tourism and Recreation and Larry Myer, Director of the Michigan Department of Commerce cut a ribbon to officially launch the Lake Huron Circle Tour Route.

"The co-operation between Michigan and Ontario in launching this tour is an excellent example of how two countries can work together to achieve something unique and positive," said Mr. Black.

"Tourism is an important industry to both sides of the border, and one in which all levels of Government and the private sector can work together for the common good," Mr. Black said. "The launch of this project during Canada's National Tourism Week is appropriate. Innovative programming such as this is needed if tourism is to continue to grow and flourish."

The Lake Huron Circle Tour follows a 2240 kilometre route around Lake Huron. The route will take people through sandy shores and rugged outcroppings, blue waters against limestone cliffs, shipwrecks, lighthouses, and crossroad villages and major cities as well as through two nations - Canada and the United States.
