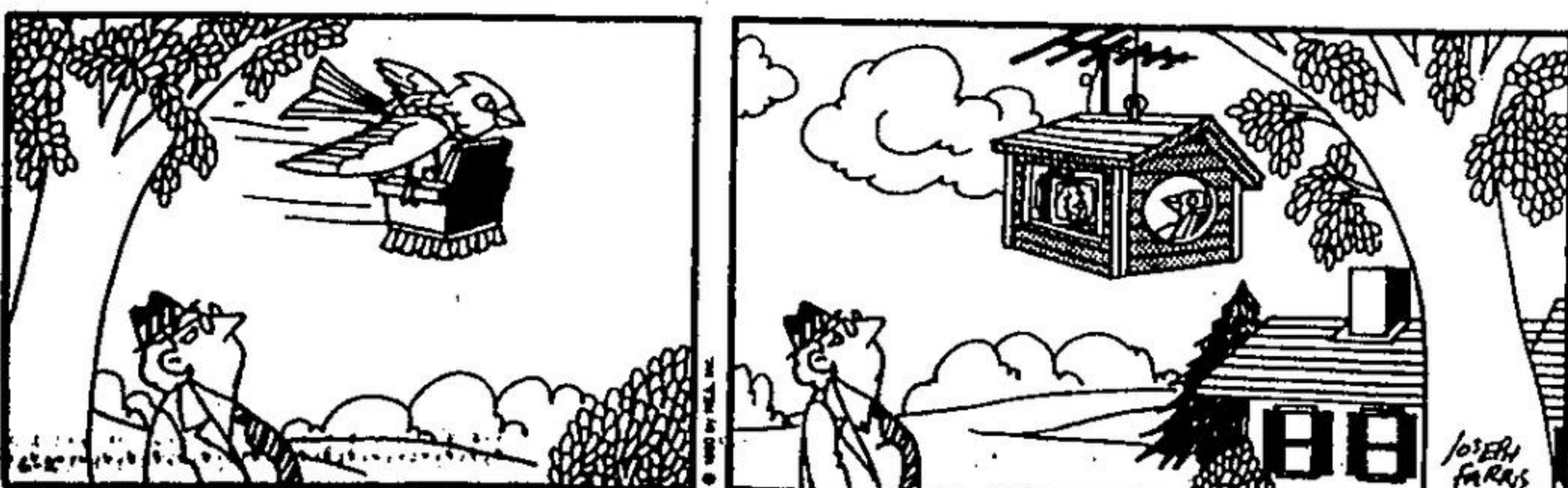

Possible answers: wood, bread, paper, apple, paper, paper, cotton shirt

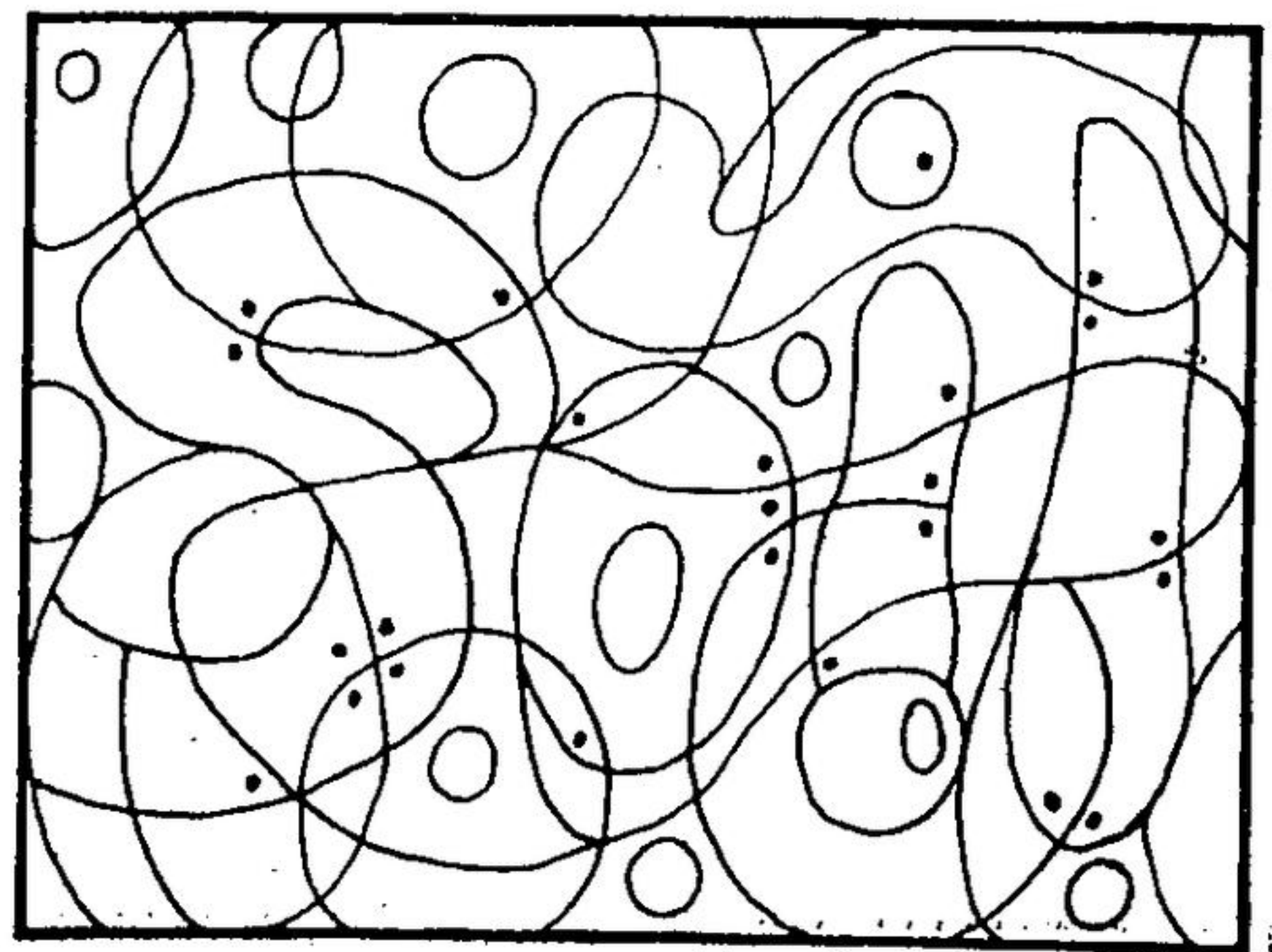
# MIX UP
