

Expect a new Asia album

DEAR ROCK ON: I would love to know if a couple of my favorite groups are planning on recording again soon. When is Genesis going to put aside their second-rate solo stuff, and enter the studio for more classic art-form rock? Also, what is the status of the supergroup Asia, led by John Wetton? — Mike, Cinnaminson, N.J.

DEAR MIKE: You'll be happy to hear that Asia will be releasing a new album, entitled "Then & Now," on July 24. They're still on the Geffen label.

Genesis will also be recording again, even though the solo successes of Phil Collins and Mike & the Mechanics have delayed a full-band project. Expect the group to re-enter the studio together "at some point in 1991," according to Atlantic Records.

DEAR ROCK ON: I know that country rocker k.d. lang's initials stand for Katherine Dawn. But why why

doesn't she spell her name (or her song lyrics) with capital letters? — Mary Anne, Russellville, Ark.

DEAR MARY ANNE: The lower-case usage is an homage to poet e.e. cummings, whose work Lang admires. Please note, however, that when Lang's Sire debut LP, "Angel with a Lariat," was released in 1987, her name was spelled with both upper and lower case letters.

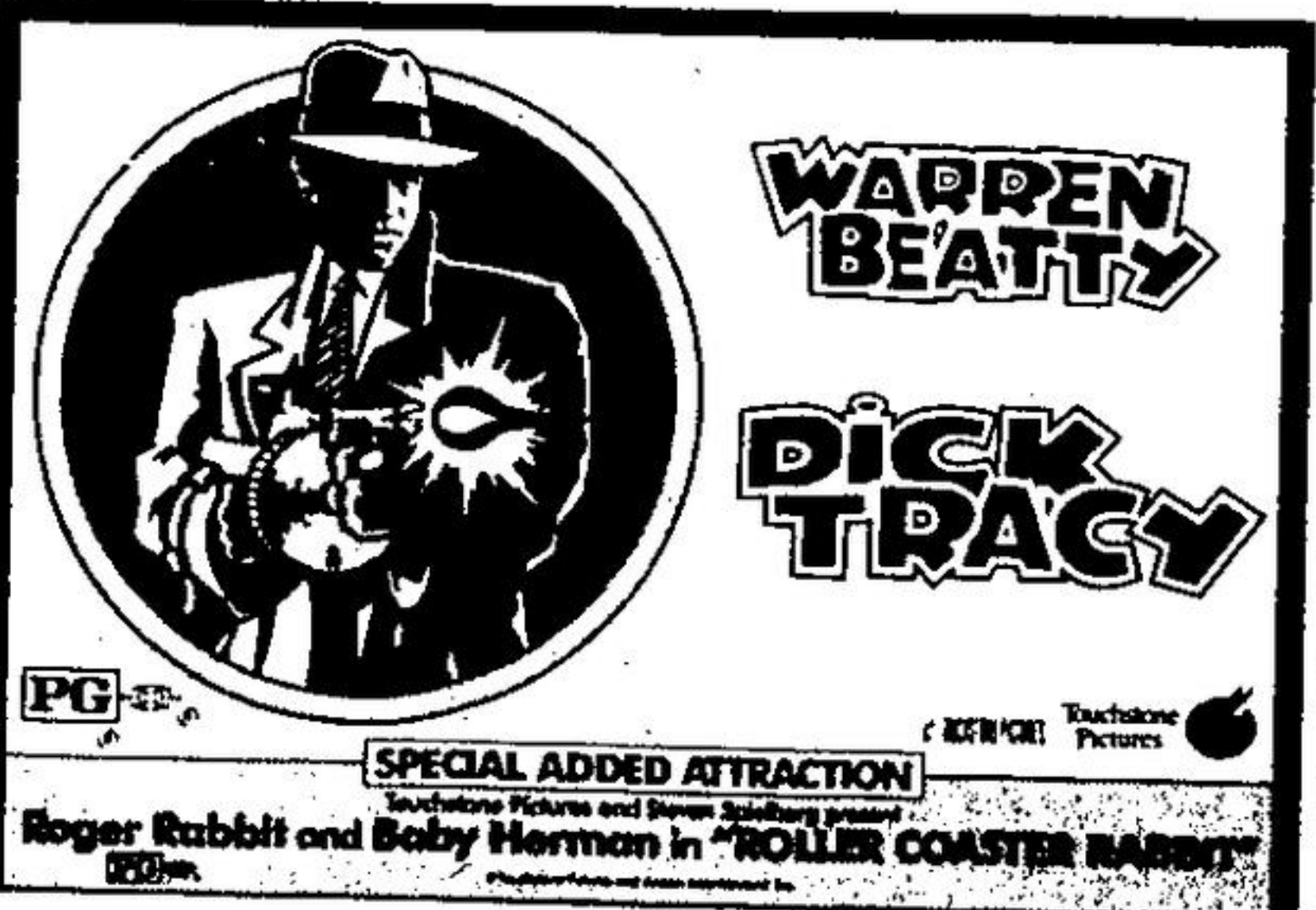
