Public will sample handicapped life at Zellers Friday

There's nothing simple about completing a shopping list for a person with a hearing, vision or mobility impairment, says an elderly services co-ordinator.

The Office for Senior Citizens' Affairs and Halton Region's Elderly Services Advisory Committee are sponsoring senior simulation exercises at Main Street Zeller on Friday at 10:00 a.m.

Retailers, local politicians and media members will be participating in the volunteer workshop Through Others' Eyes, to demonstrate the difficulty in completing everyday tasks while suffering from physical impairments.

Georgetown Mayor, Russ Miller, Halton North MPP, Walter Elliot and several local councillors are expected to participate in the awareness exercises.

Joan Kagmarski, Elderly Services Co-ordinator, said participants will be outfitted with goggles, ear plugs and heavy latex gloves and a shopping list.

The purpose of the exercise is not only force participants to appreciate the everyday struggles of life for seniors, Kagmarski said. She hopes the experience will af-

fect the participants enough so they will try to make more livable environments for seniors.

Once they know how it feels to be physically restricted they just may put that extra chair in the store, or make signs in larger print or facing someone directly when speaking, Kagmarski sald.

Kagmarski welcomes the public to view the simulations exercises.
