The Games will be held at Victoria Park, Fergus. Festivities begin at 7:30 p.m. on Friday, August 10. From Toronto, take the 401 east to Highway 6. Follow Highway 6 north to Fergus.

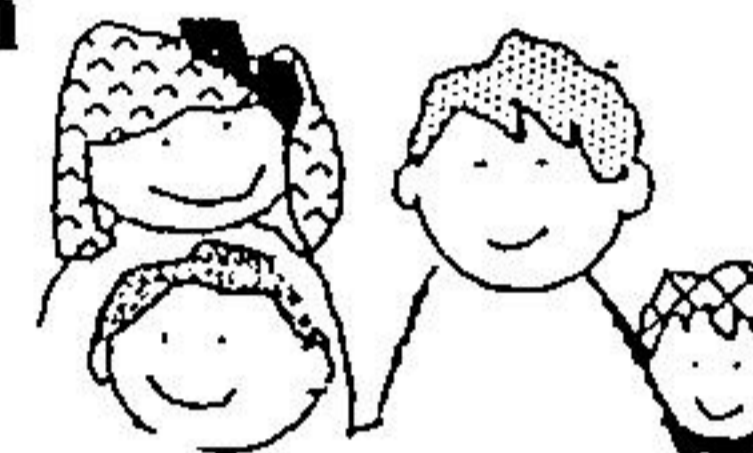
