Christine Arsenault will be presented with a \$100 award for the Adult Learner Program and two Proficiency Awards of \$100 will go to Dustin Chandler and Adrienne Harris of Bishop Reding High School.

## Church loses valued members

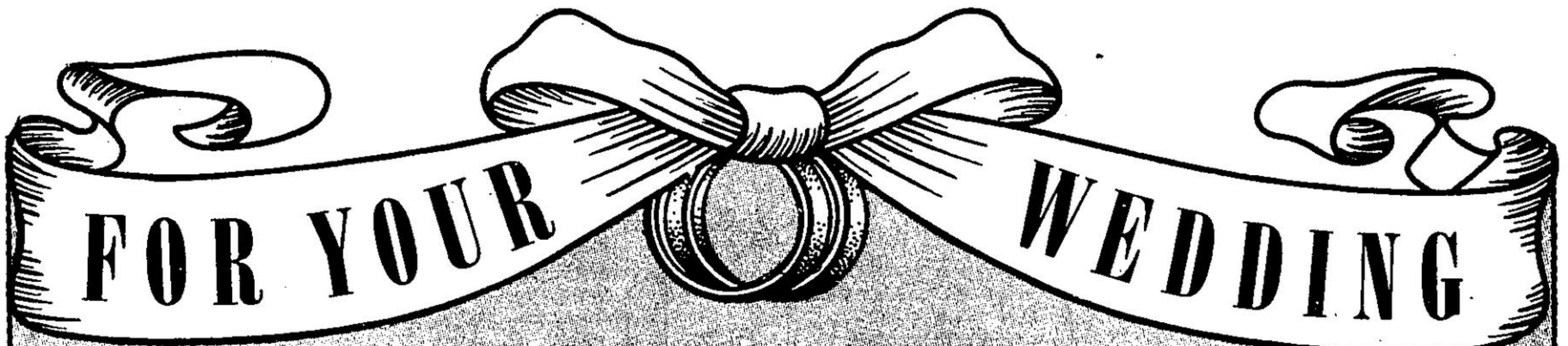
St. George's Anglican Church on Guelph Street, Georgetown, has lost two valued members of the church community recently.
