cluding bifocals, trifocals, no-line multifocals as well as hard and soft contact lenses, tints and coatings.

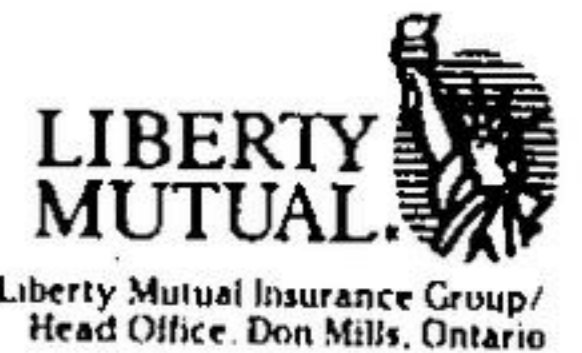
