## Cancer information provided free-of-charge

The Cancer Information Service is a toll-free telephone inquiry service that supplies factual, up-todate information about cancer and cancer-related resources to the general public, cancer patients and their families, to health professionals and the media. Specific information about cancer prevention, causes, risk' factors, particular cancer sites, methods of diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation is available.

As well, information about local resources for cancer patients and families - treatment facilities, home care programs, volunteer and self-help programs - is available. The Service is also able to provide information and support around palliative care issues. Our information ranges from very general information through very specific research protocols to resources available across the Province of Ontario. Information given by telephone is often sup-

plemented by written material mailed to the caller at no charge.

The Cancer Information Service is staffed by trained personnel who respond to calls with specific individualized information in layman's language, and provide the opportunity for the caller to discuss his concerns fully.

The assurance of confidentiality or anonymity provided by the Service often proves to be an asset. Callers can ask very basic or personal questions without fear or embarrassment. Callers are not required to give their names or other information about themselves.

One of the major aims of a Cancer Information Service is to reduce the widespread fear and confusion surrounding cancer, by providing a current, factual, readily available source of information, This will assist the public in understanding and coping with the disease in family, friends and associates.

In Ontario, the Cancer Informa-
