30 Years Ago

A meeting was held in Milton by the North Halton Cancer Unit to re-organize and expand the unit. Because of the growing need for more service in the north-end of the county, it was decided to form branches of the cancer unit in Georgetown and in Acton. This plan was met with great enthusiasm from both towns.

The education committee of the cancer unit reported that most of the industries in North Halton were visited by the committee during the previous summer. The committee discussed prevention of cancer with the workers, they also showed films on the subject, and distributed literature on cancer to the groups visited.

While the committee was visiting these businesses, they interviewed a considerable amount of people, and as a result, one woman and four men were advised to report to their family doctors for an examination.

20 Years Ago

The Georgetown Rebels junior football team commenced a new season of play on a brand-new field, and clinched a 14-1 victory. The Rebels beat out the Milton Mustangs on McLaren Field, named after Lyn McLaren, in a pre-game ceremony.

McLaren had left the school after 11 years in the G.D.H.S. Phys-Ed department, and had taken a job as vice-principal of Robinson Secondary School in Burlington.

The first half of the game resulted in only one point scored, a Mustangs kick. However, the Rebels came back in the third quarter to take a 7-1 lead.

The second Rebel touchdown came as a surprise to both teams, the Rebel punter ran down the field under his own kick, picked up the ball off the bounce, and ran the final ten yards for a touchdown.

10 Years Ago

A 28-day old strike at Maple Lodge Farms ended when employees agreed upon a new two-year contract in a 189 to three vote.

The strike began when approximately 200 out of the 325 workers employed by the plant, unionized under the United Food and Commercial Workers Union, walked off the job. The striking workers were protesting low pay, poor "time off" schemes, and long hours. The workers strike nearly forced the plant to shut down. Maple Lodge Farms is the largest chicken processing plant in Canada.

The striking workers demand an 80 cent per hour increase in their wages in each year of a two year contract, the first, January. Workers only earned \$6.20 per hour prior to the strike.

5 Years Ago

Two local soccer teams, Mosquito and Atom teams, captured Ontario championship titles. The two teams won their respective Mid-Ontario soccer league championships after finishing their regular season in top spot.

The Georgetown Bantam team also captured, but lost both of their games.

In the Atom championship, the Atom team defeated Hillsburgh 9-1 in their opening game, and tied with Fergus in their second game 2-2. The Atom team went on to easily defeat Grand Valley 11-0 in their third game.

The Mosquito team had a more difficult time with their championship games; the Georgetown team beat both Fergus and Grand Valley, 4-2 and 2-1 respectively. The Mosquito team won their third and final game against Hillsburgh by default, the Hillsburgh Mosquito team failed to show up for the game.
