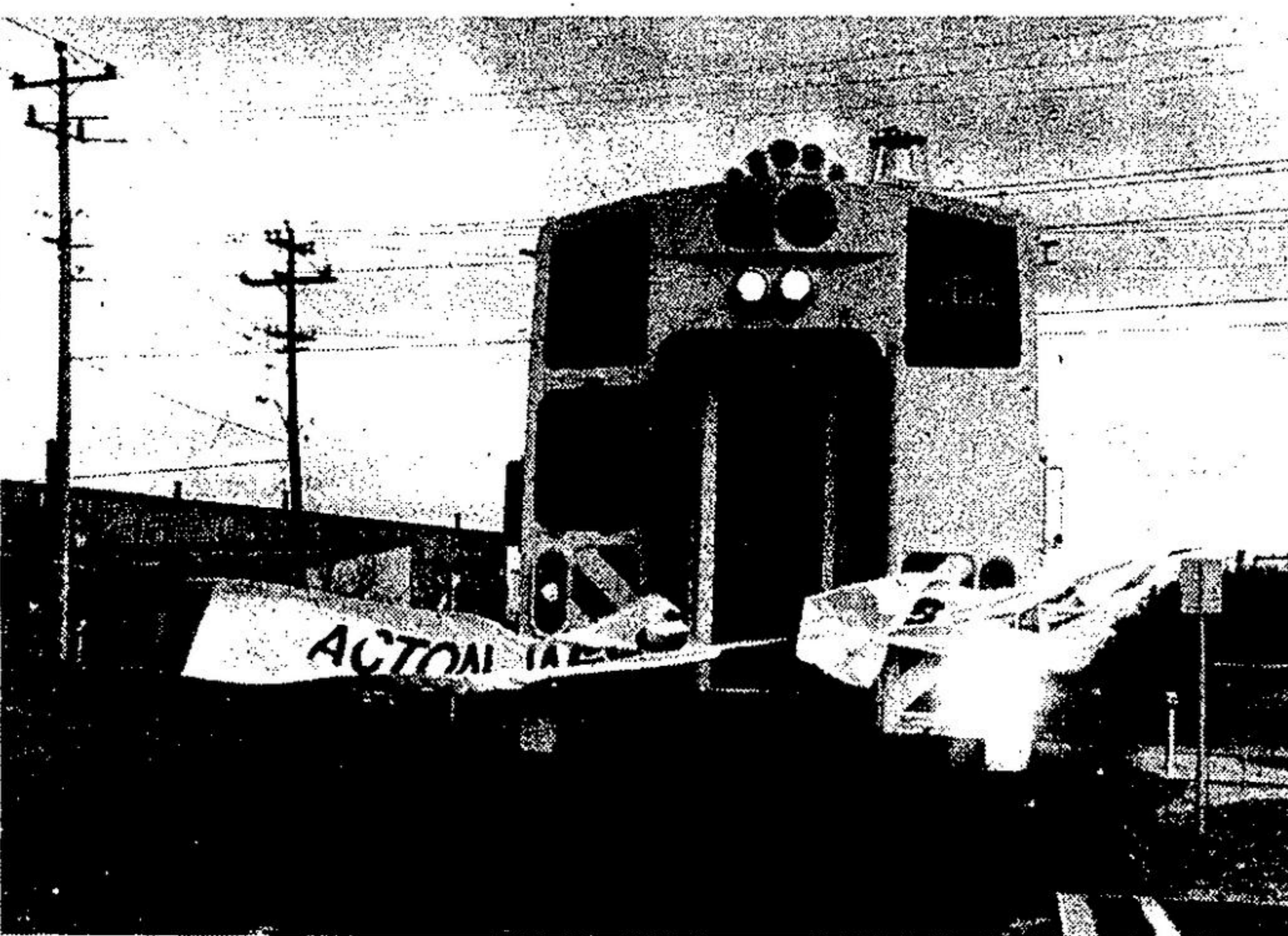


# Community

(Therapeutic Electrical Stimulation) and the progress being made in treatment of muscular disabilities as well as an explanation of the new Research Facilities.
