











Chocolate Party

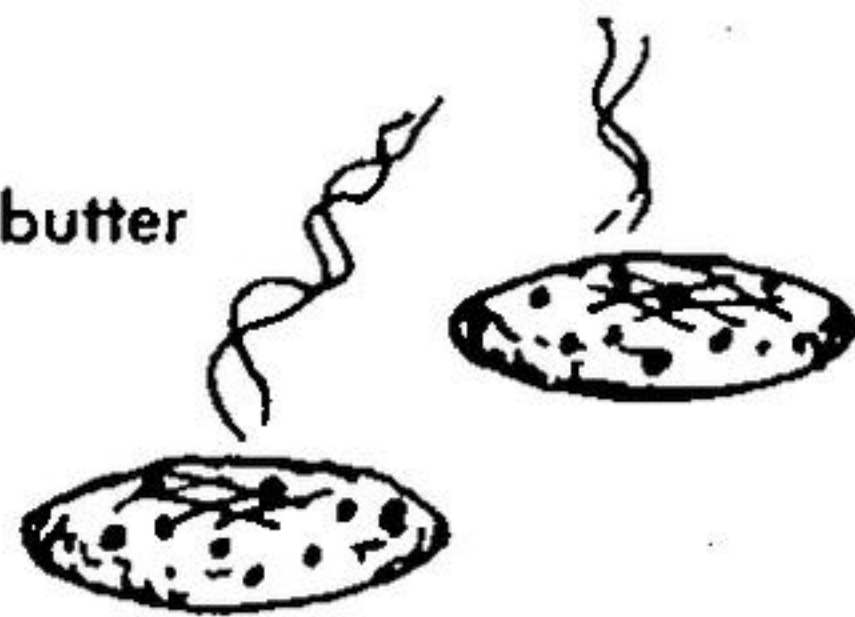
Cookie Time



Chocolate chip cookies are the number one best selling cookie in America. Here is a delicious chocolate chip cookie recipe that you can make from scratch. Be sure to get an adult to help you.

Ingredients:

- 1/2 stick softened margarine or butter
- 2/3 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 1/2 cups buttermilk biscuit mix
- 1/4 cup flour
- 1 6-oz. package semisweet chocolate chips



What to do:

1. Heat oven to 375 degrees. Grease cookie sheet with shortening.
2. Mix butter, brown sugar and egg in bowl.
3. Stir in biscuit mix and flour and mix until smooth.
4. Stir in chocolate chips.
5. Drop dough by rounded teaspoonfuls onto the greased cookie sheet.
6. Bake in 375 degree oven for 8-10 minutes. Take cookies off cookie sheet immediately using pancake turner.
