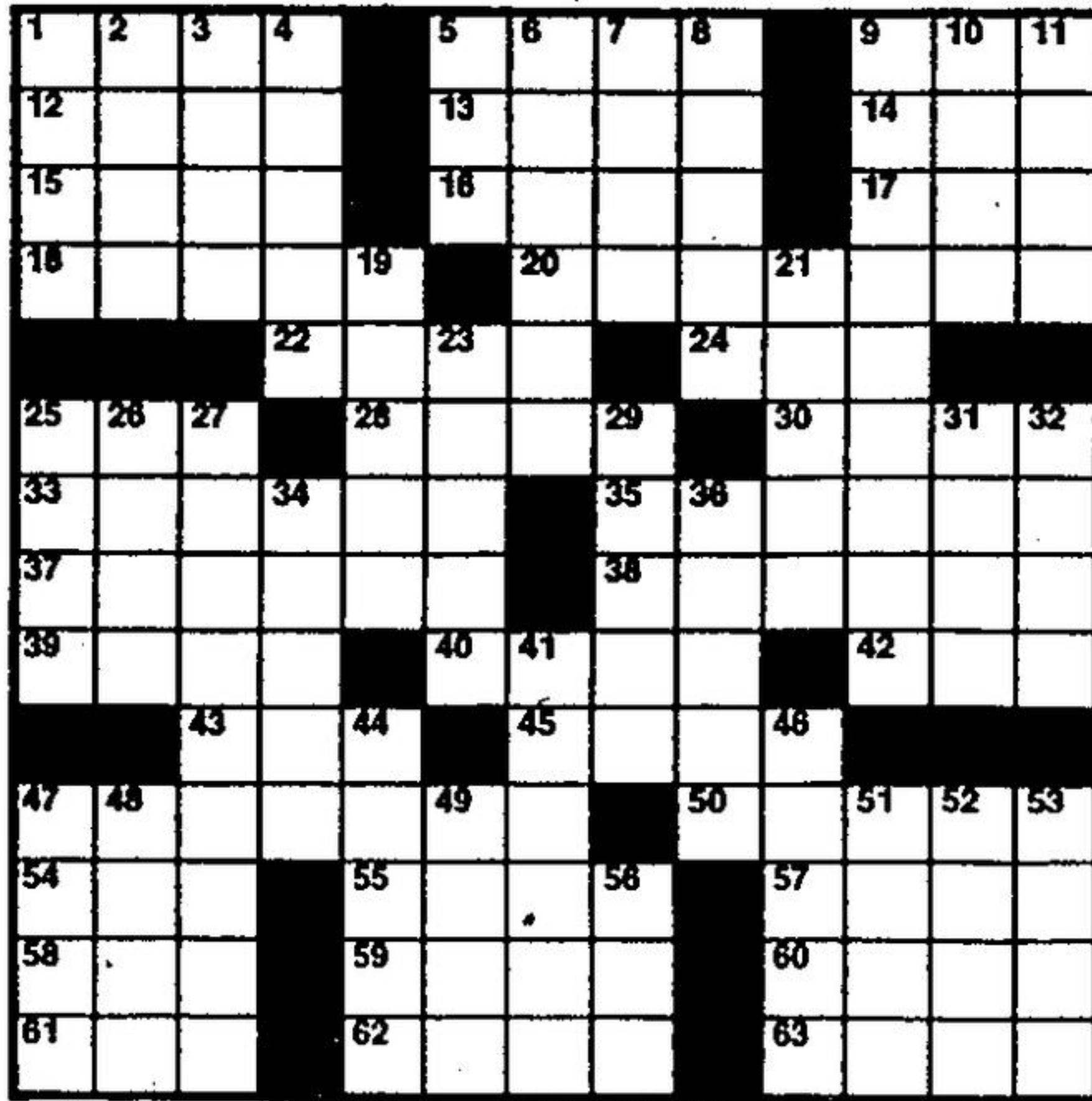


Crossword Puzzle

ual harassment is and to help management become informed and understanding, when it comes to sexual assault victims.

Dupont has made it clear to all employees what they will do for victims of assault and have actually written up a set of guidelines for the issue. They have extended the eight-hour program to include wives and daughters of employees.

"No other company is doing this to this extent," Ms. Grear pointed out. In fact Dupont won an Employment Equity Award, granted by the Women's Directorate, in 1987 and the Solicitor General's Award of Canada for Crime Prevention in 1988.

Dupont, located at Mississauga and Derry Roads in Mississauga, has had the program in place for the last five years.

The Halton Board of Education

Sue Amos will explain the many programs now being offered by the board, including instruction of children, adolescents and adults.

Child Abuse Prevention programs are in place for grades one, three and five students in all Halton Public Schools. The aim is "to be pro-active with kids," said Ms. Amos. "So we're not just reacting" to an abusive situation.

Adolescents taking physical education and health or human sexuality classes will also receive instruction about abuse. The emphasis is on assertiveness and self-esteem for these students.

The Board has taken a new approach in its programs, Ms. Amos explained. The emphasis is on life skills such as decision making, assertiveness, resistance skills and enhancement of self-esteem.

Some of the programs have been in place for several years and some are fairly new. The Halton School Board has responded with progressive initiatives in the area of assault and abuse.
