Our boys have no home because the landlord refused to bring our home up to code so the Board of Health condemned it and we had to move out right away. My husband got layed off two weeks short of being able to collect U.I.C. I make \$300.00 every two weeks and we have no home or money for first and last months rent.

This close to Christmas, our only option for our sons to be safe and fed is to put them in a foster home because there is no aid or service to help a family stay together. We have contacted everyone from MP's to Social Services. Children's Aid to the Crisis Center and no one can help us stay together. Our sons are seven and eight and all we can give them for Christmas is being separated from their parents who love them very much.

My Christmas list for my boys is very short. I wish I could have a home so my family doesn't have to be torn apart but instead we could stay together the way it should

I love my sons more than life itself and this just breaks my heart.

I've tried everything and everyone I could think of to get help for us and now all I have left is to pray for a Christmas miracle.

Mrs. L Ball P.S. Let my miracle prayer be felt for others in similar situations and my disgust for the Canadian Government for letting something like this happen with no options to help people.

Thank you There are shelters for single parents, shelters' for abused women and*or children, aid for convicts being released from jail but no aid or help for families being abused and/or neglected by the government or who fall between the huge cracks in our present system.






