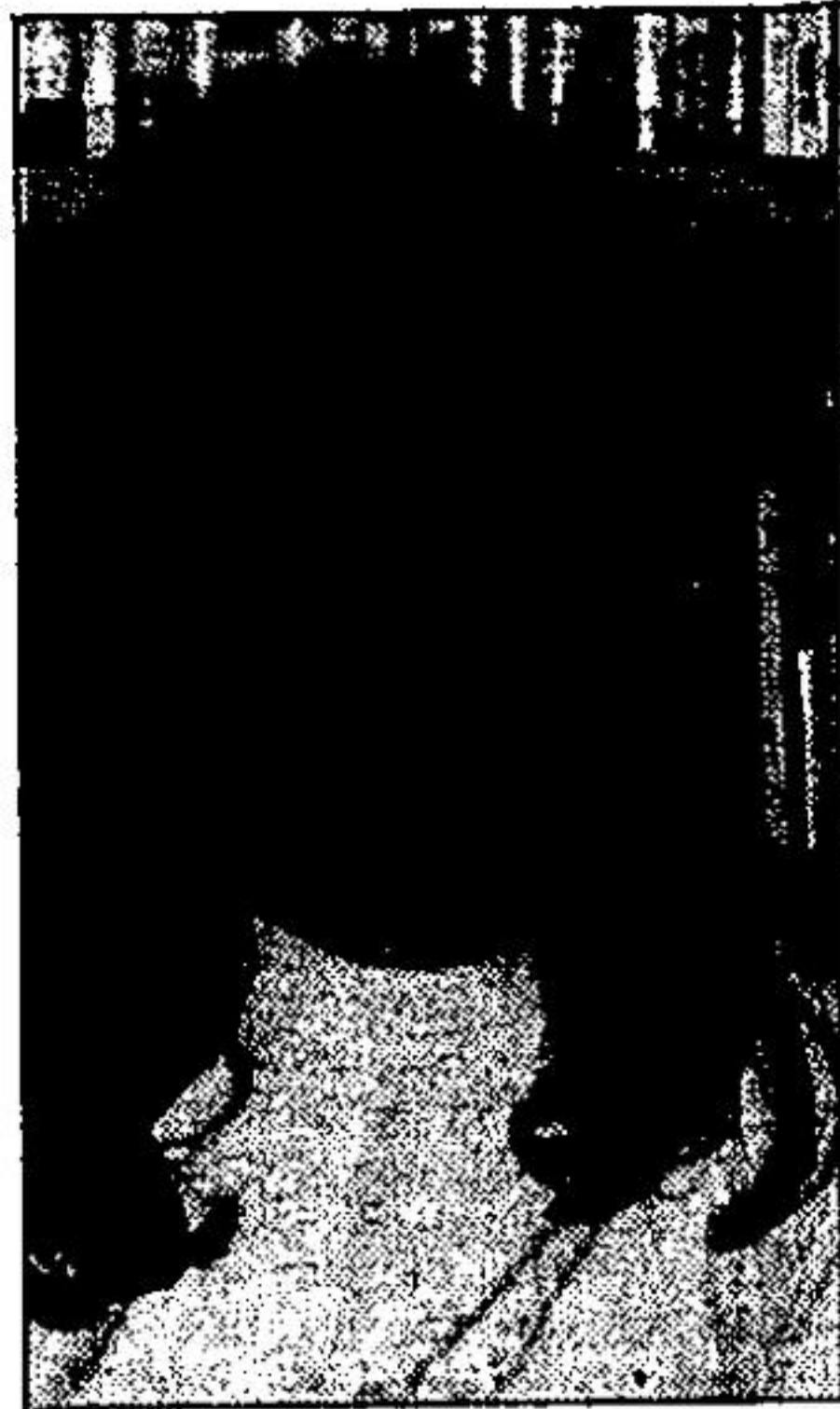

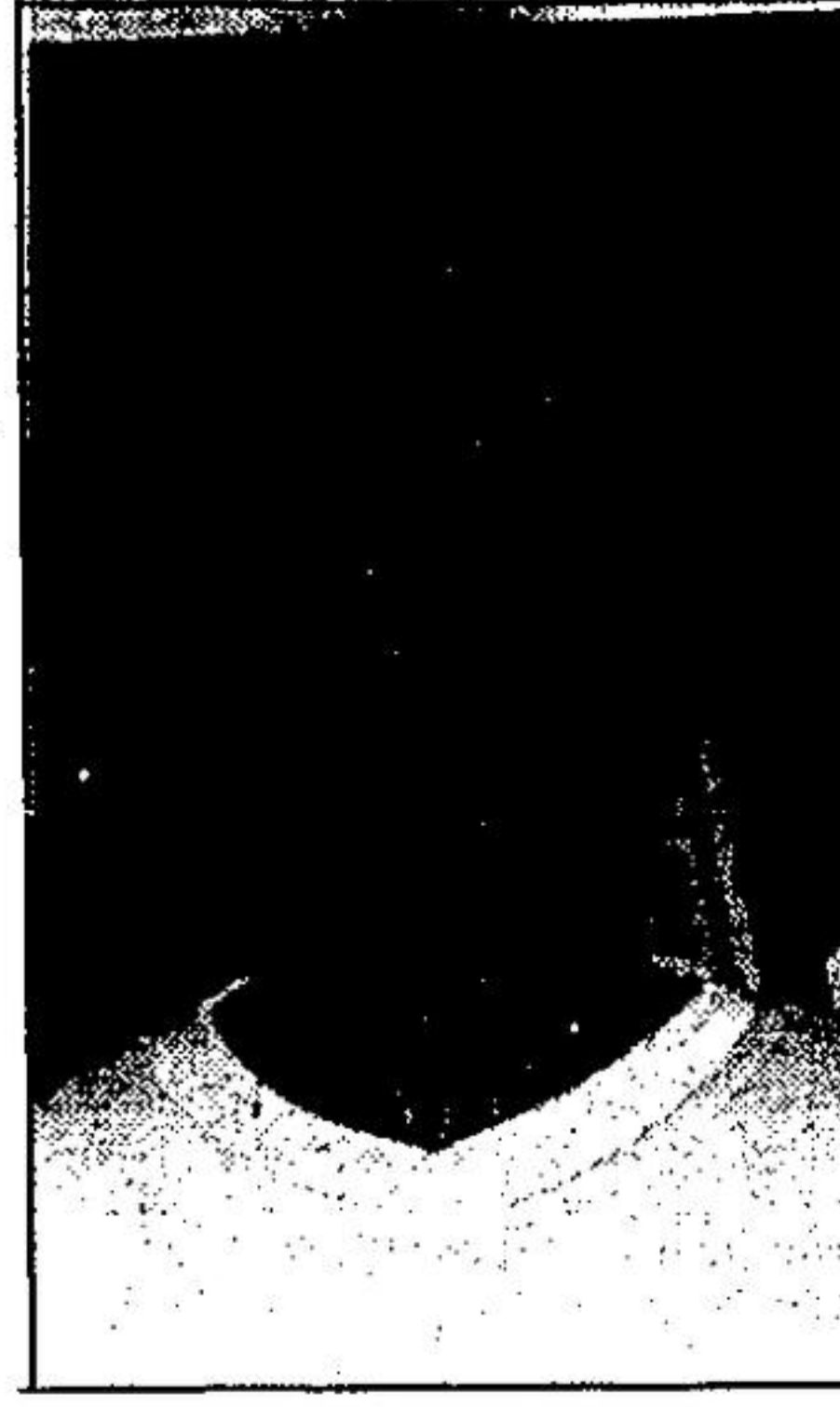
What is your favorite subject?

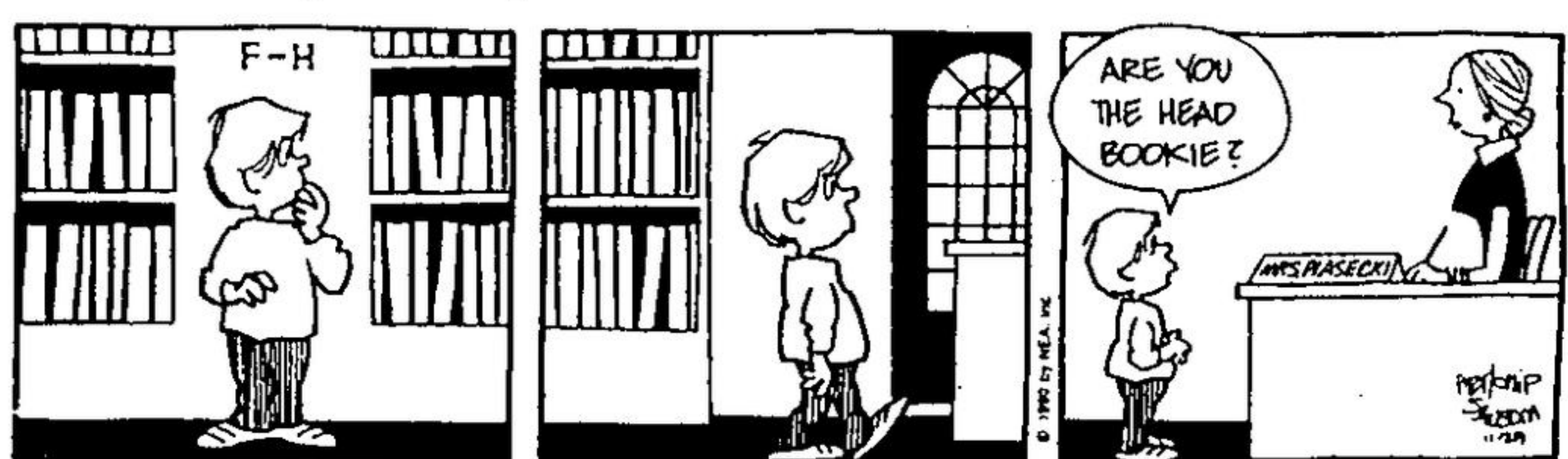
