You fill our hearts o'er flowing.

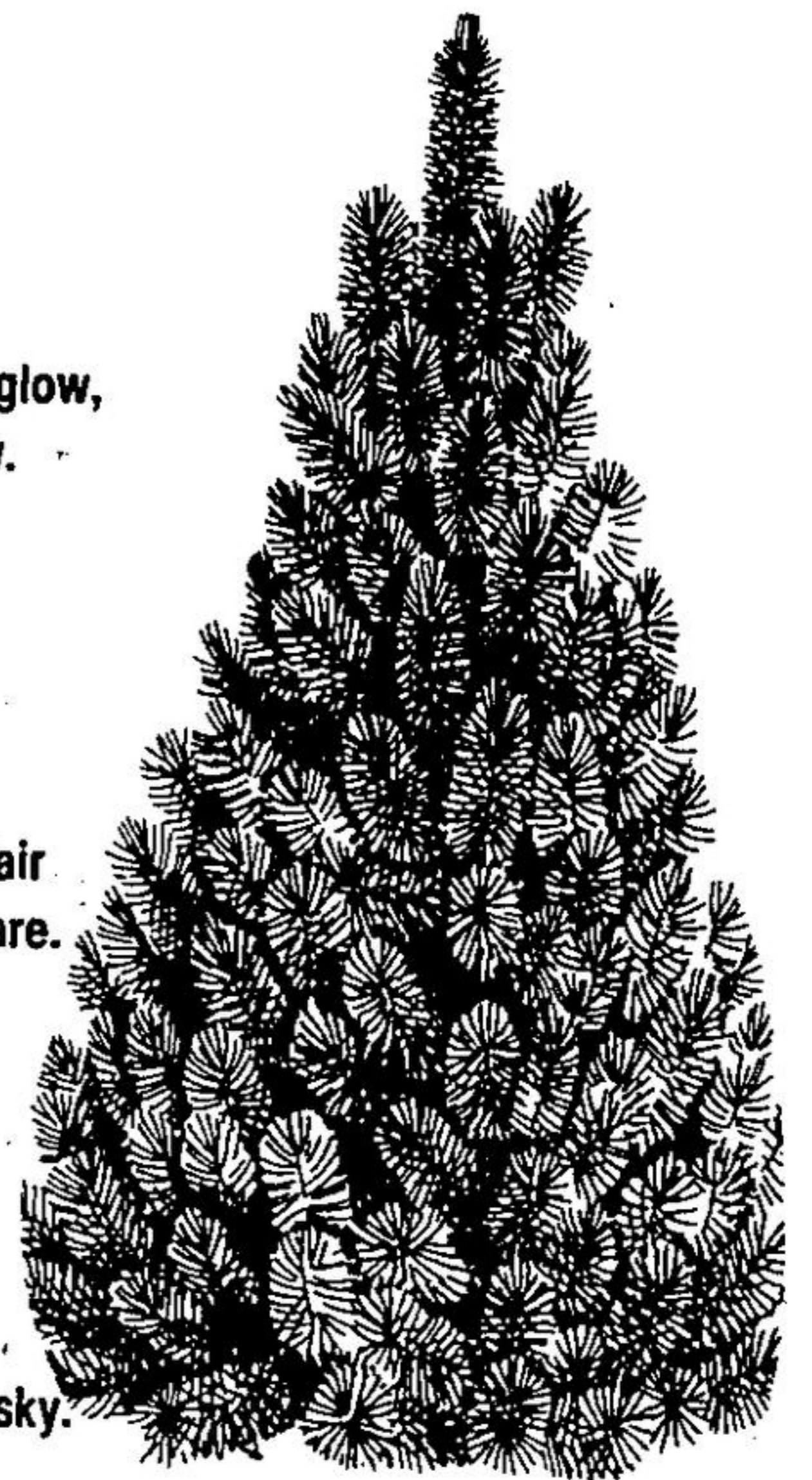


## O Faithful Pine
