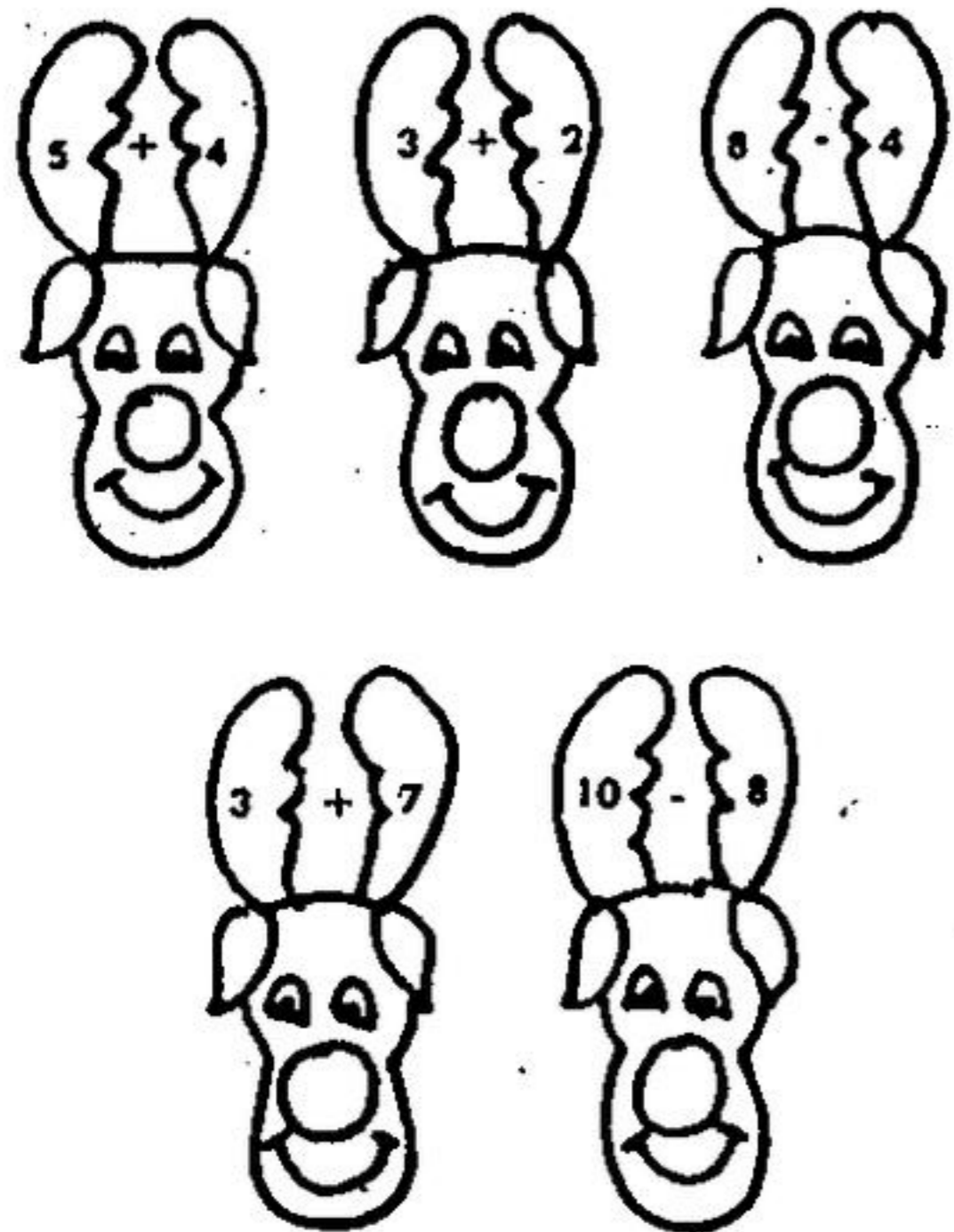


ROSY NOSES

I have been a good girl this year.

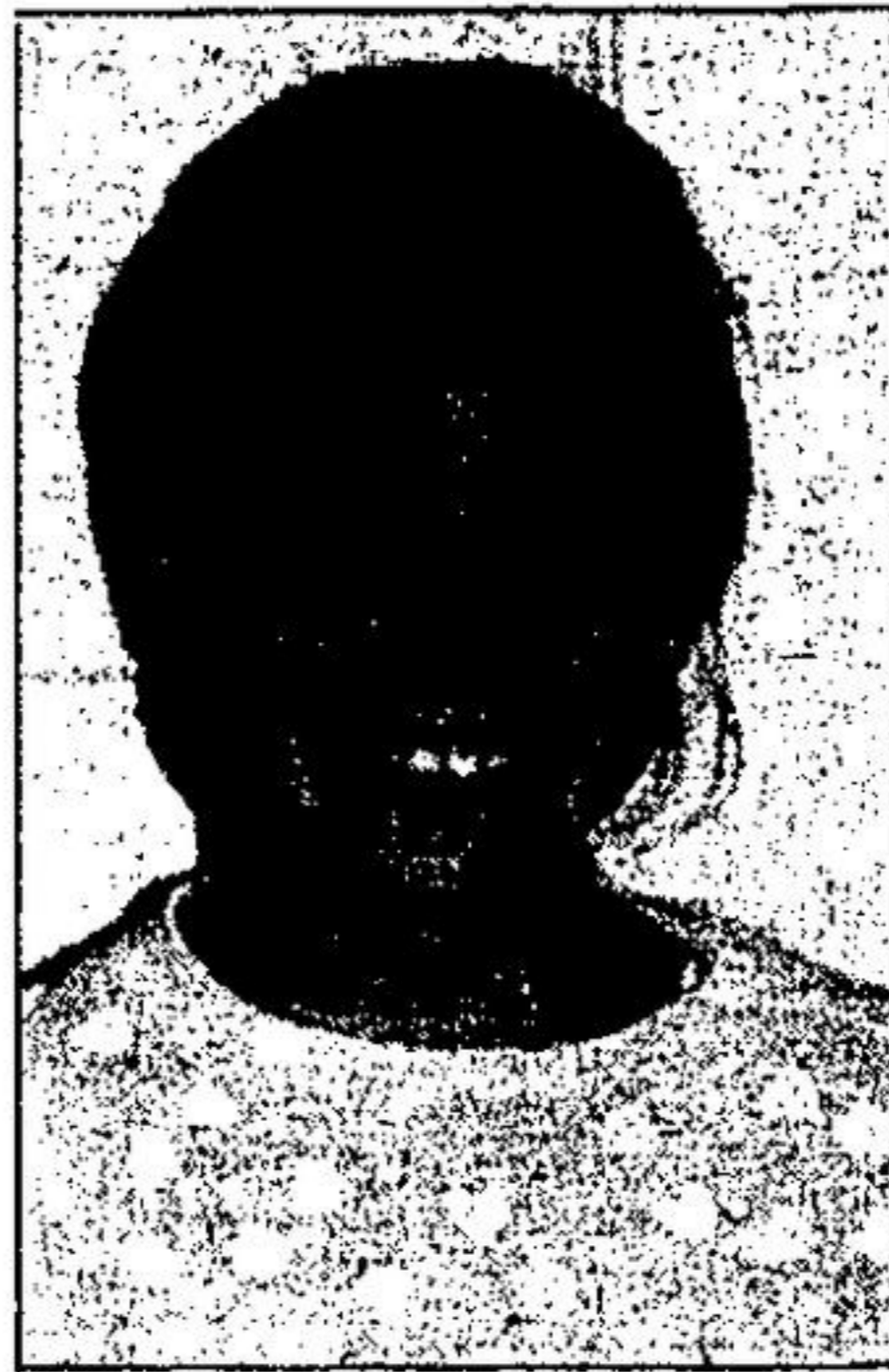

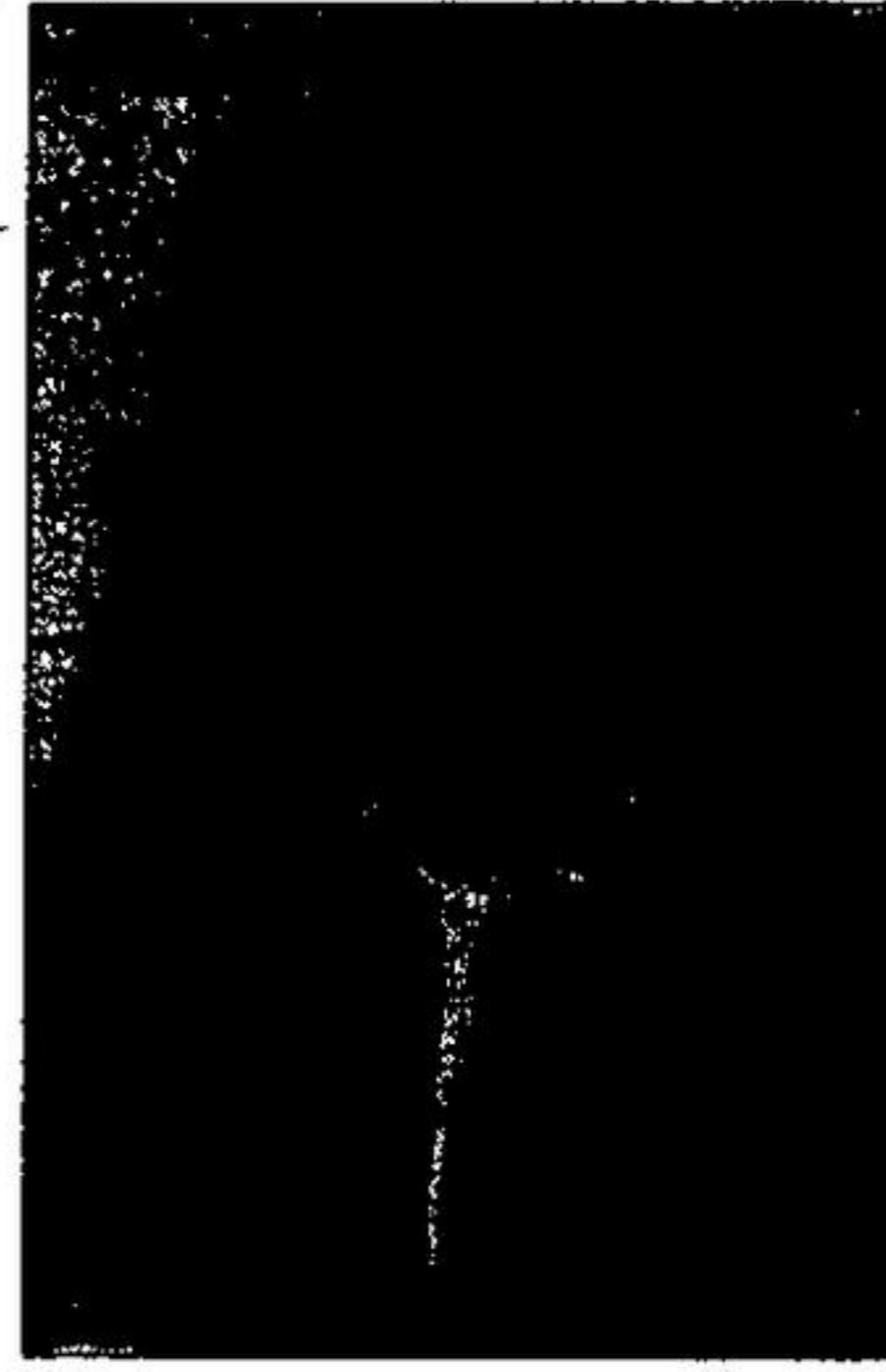
Dear Santa,

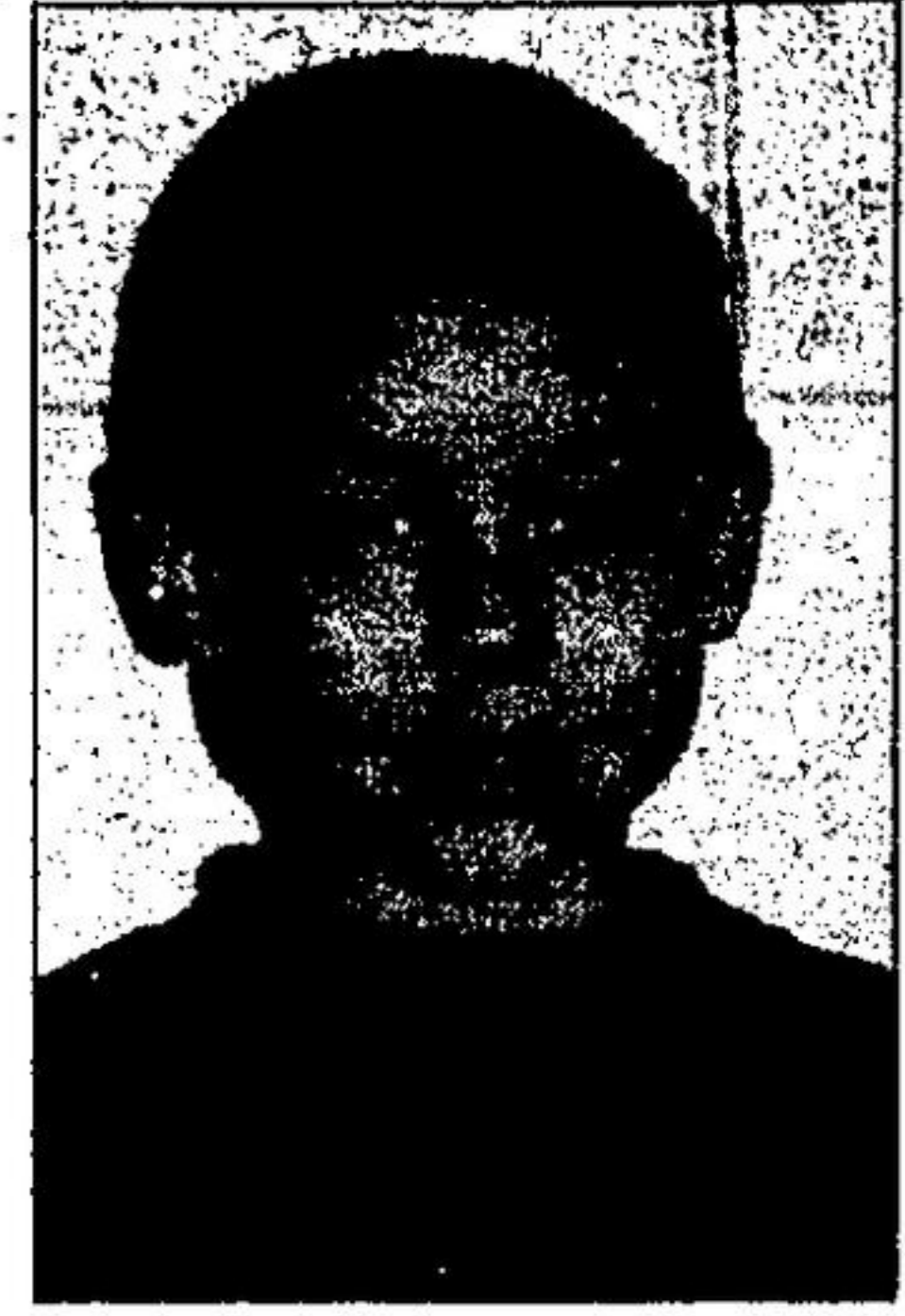
Youth Forum Are you dreaming of a White Christmas?
