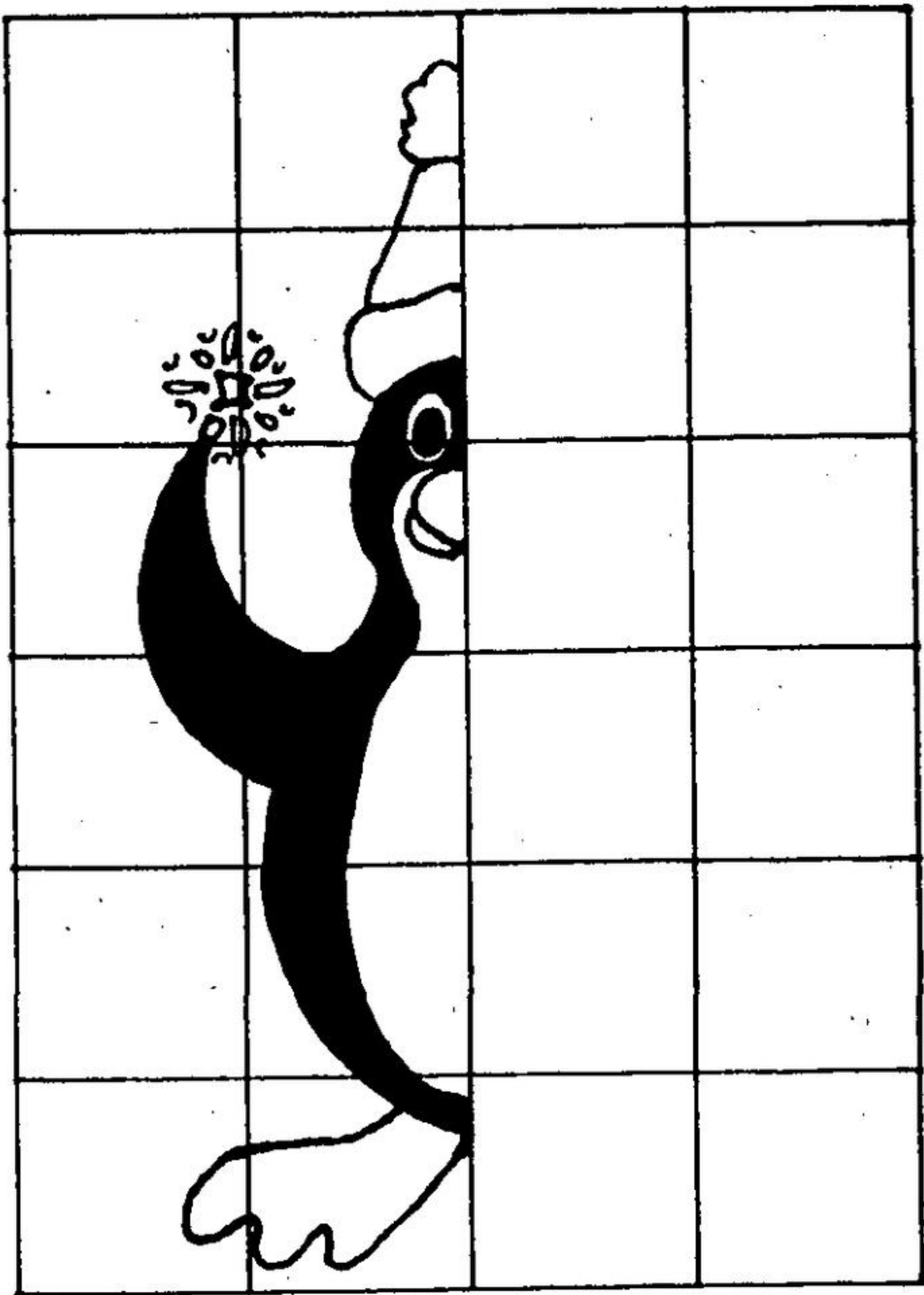
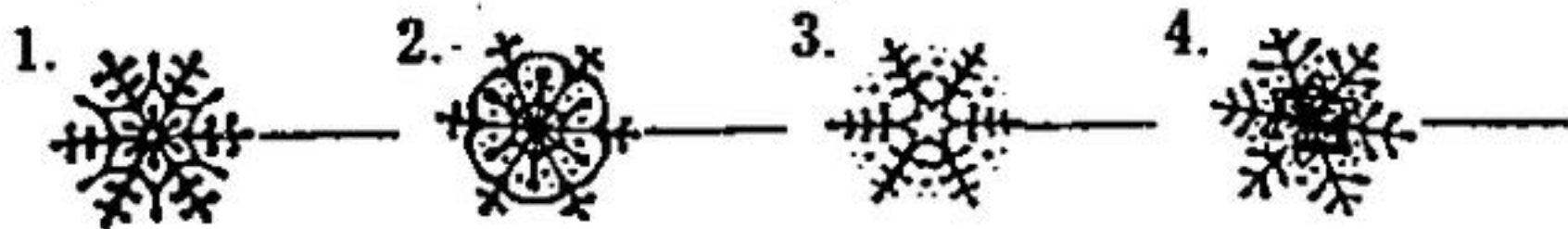


Use the grid lines to complete the picture of our winter friend.

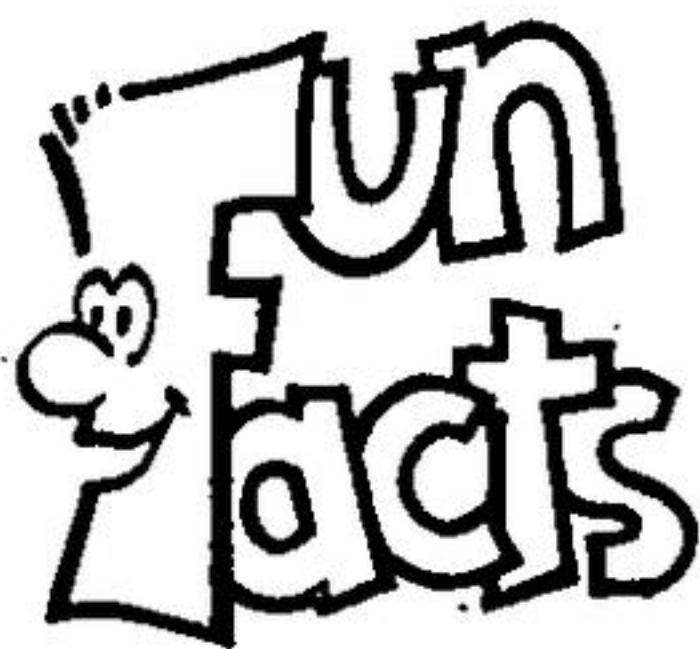


Snowflake Fun

2. Skaters are advised never to skate on a natural ice surface that

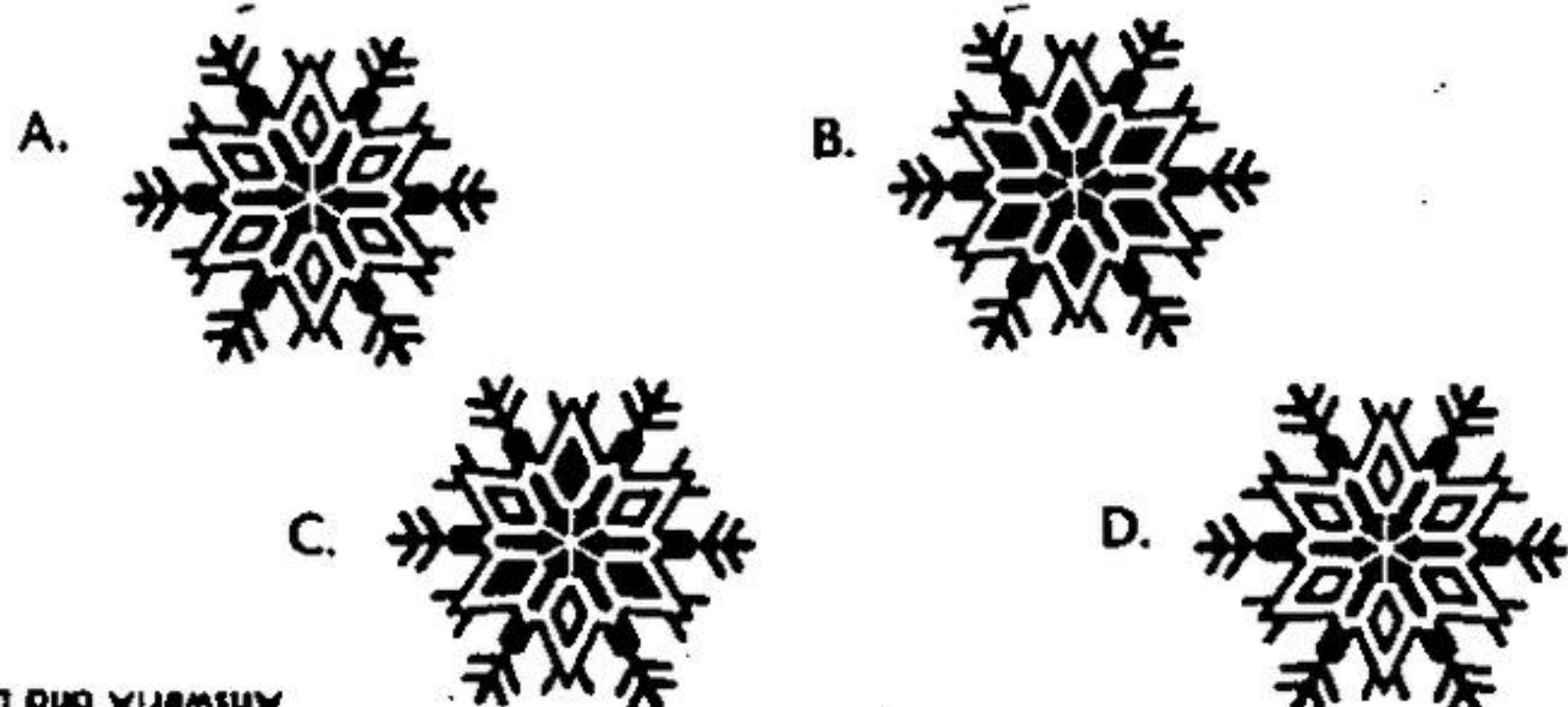
is less than 4 inches thick because of the danger of falling through thin ice.
