Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital is pleased to announce they have a new roof over their heads.

Over the summer and fall of 1990 the roof deck of the Hospital was replaced. Schreiber Bros. of Hamilton was the contractor responsible for the replacement of the 60,000 sq. ft. of roof deck.

The project was overseen by Fishburn Roofing Sciences Group Ltd. of Hornby. The total capital cost of the project was \$515,000. This project was funded by the Ministry of Health and the Region of Halton and the hospital expressed gratitude for their support of this necessary replacement.

Now that the roof has been replaced, a major painting program is planned within the facility.

Among the items covered at the public portion of the Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital board meeting was the introduction by chairman Graham

Goebelle of Doctor Debbie Zeni as the new President of the Medical Staff and highlighting her credentials and career.

The board further covered correspondence from Oakville Trafalgar Memorial Hospital asking them to participate in a Cancer study and the board agreed pending verification as to costs.

Both the Finance Committee and Long Range Planning Committee reported on progress to date of the negotiations for the Nursing Home.

The Hospital Auxiliary reported on the upcoming fund raisers, the Country Western Dance May 4th and the Family

Fiesta Bake Sale planned for May 25th.
