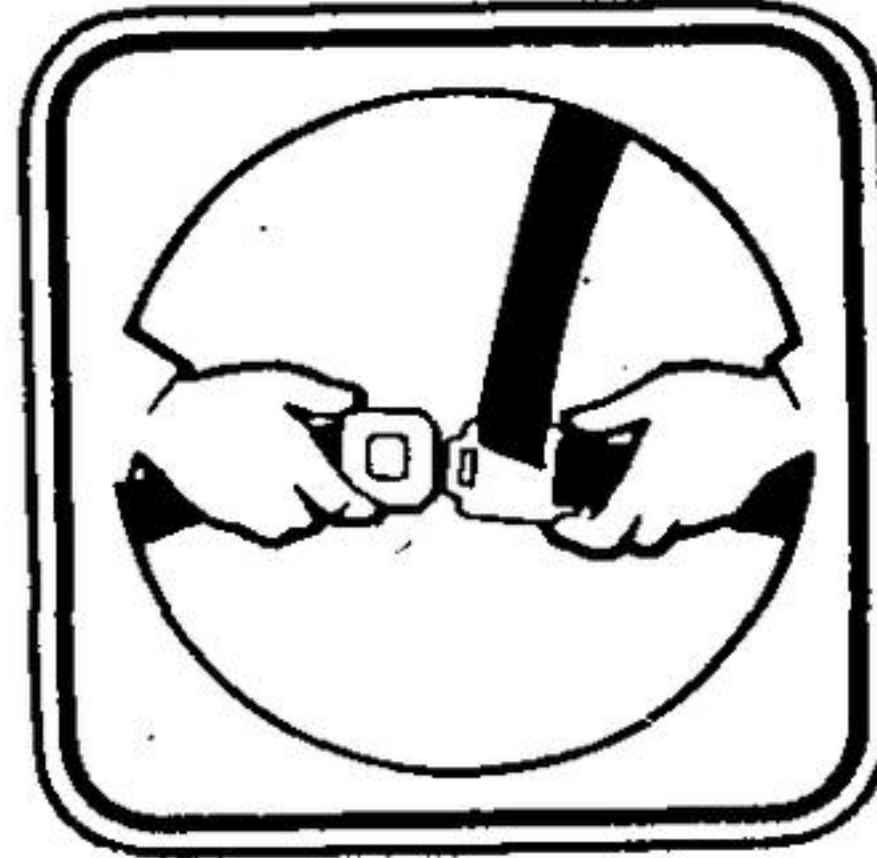
Trevor Cash skated hard to break up an Orangeville threat at the 11:17 mark of the second period to keep the game scoreless.
