Children benefit from Lions aid

Among hearing handicapped children, there is a group who have additional problems such as Cerebral Palsy, Blindness, Mental Retardation and Emotion Disturbances. Often, these children do not have a family, or if they do, parents are unable to cope or have rejected the child.

The Lions Clubs of Multiple District "A" and The Ontario Mission for the Deaf have undertaken to provide group homes for these children, for most of whom, this is their only home and family. The group home parents are unique in that they themselves are handicapped, and yet provide love and understanding which these children need.

The Lions of Multiple, District "A" have provided homes in Milton, Woodbridge, Brantford, Belleville and London, where multiple handicapped deaf children from Ontario, Quebec

and Labrador live. Homes are situated within commuting distance of provincially operated schools for the hearing handicapped.

The Lions role in this unique project is to buy or build appropriate family dwellings capable of houseing eight to ten including the house parents. The Ontario Mission for the Deaf under the direction of Chinguacousy Lion, Rev. Bob Rumball operates the homes.

To date the mortgages on all homes have been retired giving freedom to commence building a new \$3,500,000 home in Sudbury which will service Northern Quebec and Ontario.

The Lions of Georgetown are contributing \$500 annually to this exciting project in the name of a deserving Lion. For this, the Lion is presented "The Helen Keller" Award.
