sang these lyrics many years ago. His words haunt and challenge me to look for anwers to the environmental crisis which we now face.

Before I look for answers, I reflect on why we have collectively failed to be better stewards of planet earth. The reasons are many.

Our educators have failed to give us early and adequate warnings. Our politicians have ignored and denied the magnitude of the situation. Our industrialists have polluted and exploited the people, the soil, the waters and the air of the planet. Our physicians have failed to draw to our attention that which is fatal to the birds of the air and the fist of the waters is likely to be unhealthy for, if not ultimately fatal to humans.

Our religious teachers have failed to inform us of the interconnectedness and sacredness of forms of creation. At this special time of year, I will focus on the role that the Christian church has played in allowing the earth to become so wounded.

And God said unto them, "Be fruitful and multiply and replenish the earth and subdue it; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth." This quotation, from the first book of Genesis, has given people of the Christian faith permission to exploit the earth and to perceive other forms of life as subservient to human life.


Since the indusrial revolution, the Christian church in Europe throughout the New World, stood witness, silent for the part, to the continued destruction of the planet and to the exploitation of its bounty.

This exploitation of the earth's resources is far in excess of the actual needs of its human inhabitants. We have been conditioned to demand far more than we actually need. We have failed to distinguish the difference between our needs and our desires. Our desires are predominantly material and insatiable in contemporary North American Society.

I one spent a day with Dr. Rollo May, one of America's most psychotherapists. respected When asked about the role of religion in contemporary society, he replied that the economy had become the Godhead.

If we can see that the economy is more valued in our society than spirituality, there is hope. The hope lies in our individual and collective confessions of our errant values and ways, followed by a re-embrace of a spirituality which honours and experiences the interconnectedness of all forms of life.

This hope is being felt by an increasing number. This hope is not new. It was alluded to long ago, by two great Christian




mystics. When Meister Eckhart said "All creatures are interdependent", and when Hildegard of Bingen said: "Everything that is in the heavens, on the earth and under the earth is penetrated with connectedness, penetrated with relatedness", they were illuminating a pathway to ecological salvation.

Kentucky farmer-poet Wendell Berry summoned it up in these simple words: "The ecological teaching of the Bible is inescapable. God made the world. He (she) thinks the world is good. He (she) loves it. It's his (her)

world. He (she) never relinquished title to it. And he (she) has never revoked the conditions that oblige us to take excellent care of

As I attempt to answer Cat Stevens' question, I am reassured and joyous that an increasing number of people on this planet are experiencing their interconnectedness and interdependence with the whole of creation.

Q. I'm a bit confused. I thought the goods and services tax credit was supposed to replace the federal sales tax credit, but looking at my 1990 tax return package, I see that there are forms for both credits. Which form should t

A. You should complete both forms. 1990 is the last year far which you may claim the federal sales tax credit. The calculation is performed on Schedule 7. In addition to this farm, you must also complete form T1 GSTC and file It with your 1990 return in order to receive the goods and services tax credit that will be paid in instalments in July 1991, October 1991, January 1992 and April 1992. If, with your 1989 return, you did not apply for the goods and services tax credit payable in respect of the first part of 1991 and you qualified for it, it is not too late to do so.




