Halton Hills libraries offer March Break fun

The March Break is coming and if you're wondering how to keep your children entertained, Halton Hills libraries have some ideas for you.

During March Break, the Acton and Georgetown public libraries are offering special programs and entertainment called "Mystery at the Library".

The activities start on Tuesday, March 12 at 2:00 p.m. when children will be supplied with everything they might need to change their identity and become a top-notch detective. Children can experiment with disguises and test their investigative abilities.

The following day, the Bierdo Bros., professional musicians will be in Acton at 10:00 a.m. and Georgetown at 2:00 p.m. to perform various musical styles with 20 different instruments. Tickets for this show cost \$3,00 each.

A "Rendezvous at the Movies" will be held Thursday, March 14. This is an hour of mystery movies beginning at noon in Acton and at 1:00 p.m. in Georgetown. Acton children can bring lunch with them.

The special programming ends Friday with "Solve the Mystery" at the library. Children can discover the wonderful world of secret writing as librarians share with you some techniques based

on devices spys have used for centuries.

Other programs the library will offer in spring include a pop-up book course for children aged five to seven. The course teaches kids how to create their own books on the four Saturdays of April from 1:30 to 3:00 p.m. Parents must pre-register from March 1 to 16 and the cost is \$20 including materials.




