Visit from 'Snowbird' Special birthday

5th Georgetown Cubs were kept spellbound last Wednesday evening at their meeting held at St. Francis of Assisi School when Captain Kevin Kokotallo, former Snowbird pilot, gave a presentation on his experience with the Snowbirds.

Captain Kokotallo started with a video on the Snowbirds in flight. Formations, rolls, loops were shown with the Canadian Tutor Airplanes used for training and show.

Top speed 450 m.p.h., altitude 41,000 ft., having 70 sows per year from the Arctic Circle to Florida and Victoria B.C. to St. John's, Nfld., kept the Snowbirds busy.

He now flies for an airline in Toronto. He was a Snowbird pilot 1988-89. Originally from Regina, Sask., he told the Cubs the pilots are in extensive training for at least 1 1/2 years before they get their wing, also competition for the ground crew as well.

Captain Kokotallo told the Cubs there is a tremendous amount of concentration. There is 9 jets in the show - eleven pilots on the road. Only the lead gives spoken commands.

A question and answer period followed the video. The captain explained all about safety, gear the Snowbird pilots wear, gravity, jet stream vapor, ejecting, as well as how the competition the pilots have to be picked to become a pilot. The Snowbirds, based in Moose Jaw, Sask., started the instructing of pilots in 1970.

The Golden Hawks started in 1960. The Golden Centennials in 1967. Captain Kokotallo spoke on other countries that had teams too.

5th Georgetown pack gave two cheers of thanks to the captain for his informative presentation.
