Halton Regional Police and Crime Stoppers of Halton are requesting information that will lead to the arrest of the person or persons responsible for inflicting approximately \$10,000.00 damage to "The Bubble Tennis Club" located at 4346 Longmoor Drive in Burlington, Ontario.

Sentencing delayed

The sentencing of Brian Boudreau, who pleaded guilty to abducting his five-year-old son in January, has been delayed until March 18.

Boudreau, 35, was to be sentenced Wednesday in Milton Provincial Court for abduction and breach of probation, which he also pleaded guilty to, in connection with last spring's disappearance of Luke Boudreau.

What began as a regular visit between Mr. Boudreau and his

son turned into an intensive investigation by Halton Regional Police when Luke disappeared.

Through the investigation and an outpouring of community support for Luke's mother, Janet Cipryk of Milton, the pair were found by authorities in Hawaii. last October.

Mr. Boudreau was also charged with extortion and conspiracy to commit an indictable offence but those charges withdrawn.


